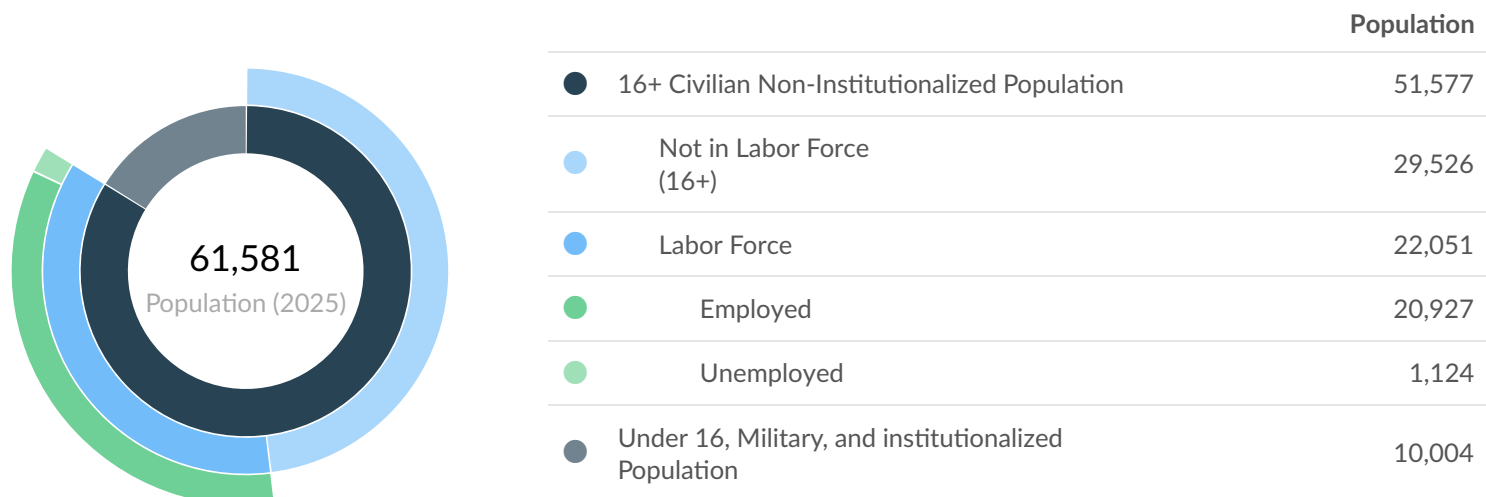
Regional average earnings per job are **\$33.3K below** the national average earnings of \$85.0K per job.

Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **increased by 4.2%** since 2019, growing by 2,437. Population is expected to **increase by 3.9%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 2,380.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 3.7%** in 2 Arkansas Counties from 21,273 to **22,054**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 0.2%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 46.4% to 44.9% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.7% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.7% below the national average), and **11.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).

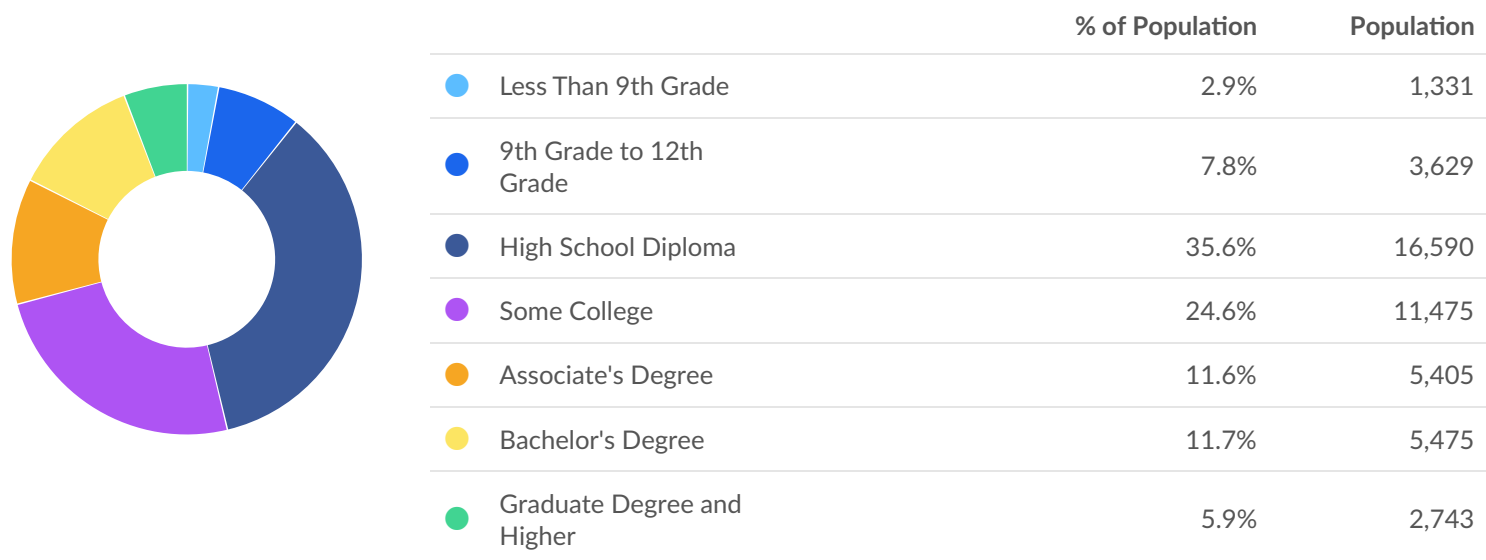

Feb 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



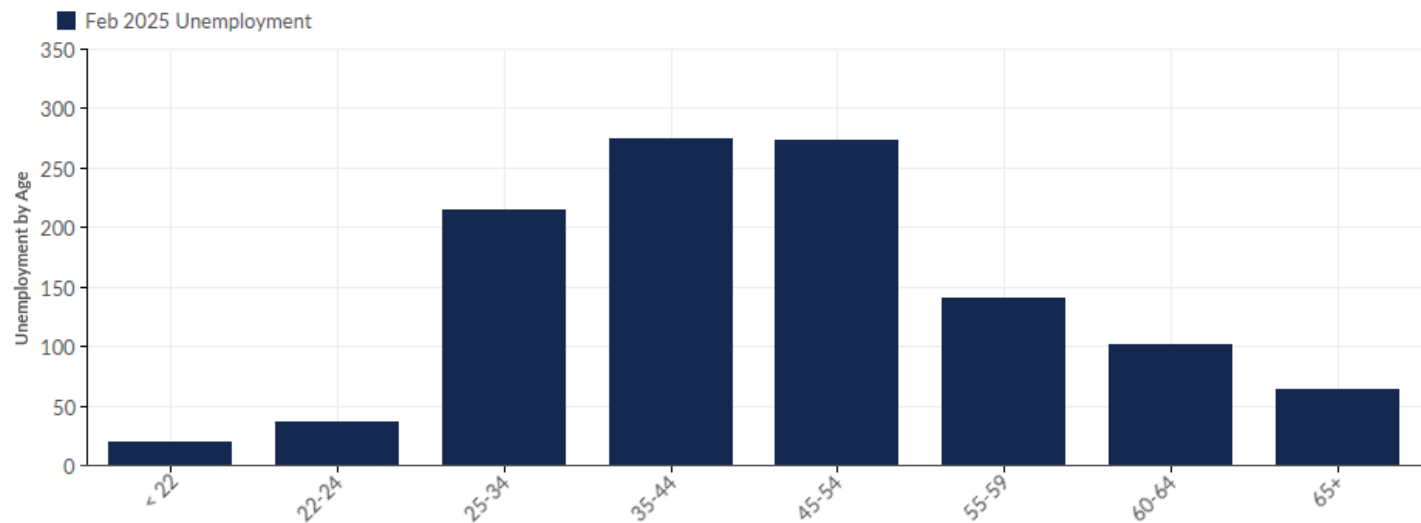
Educational Attainment

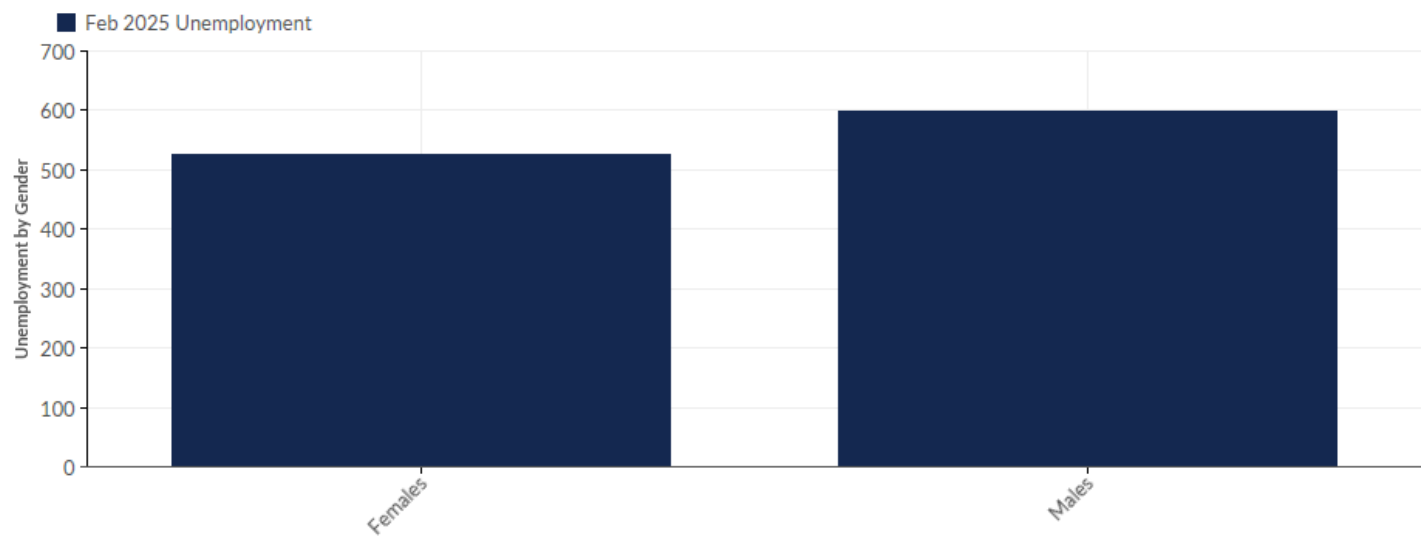

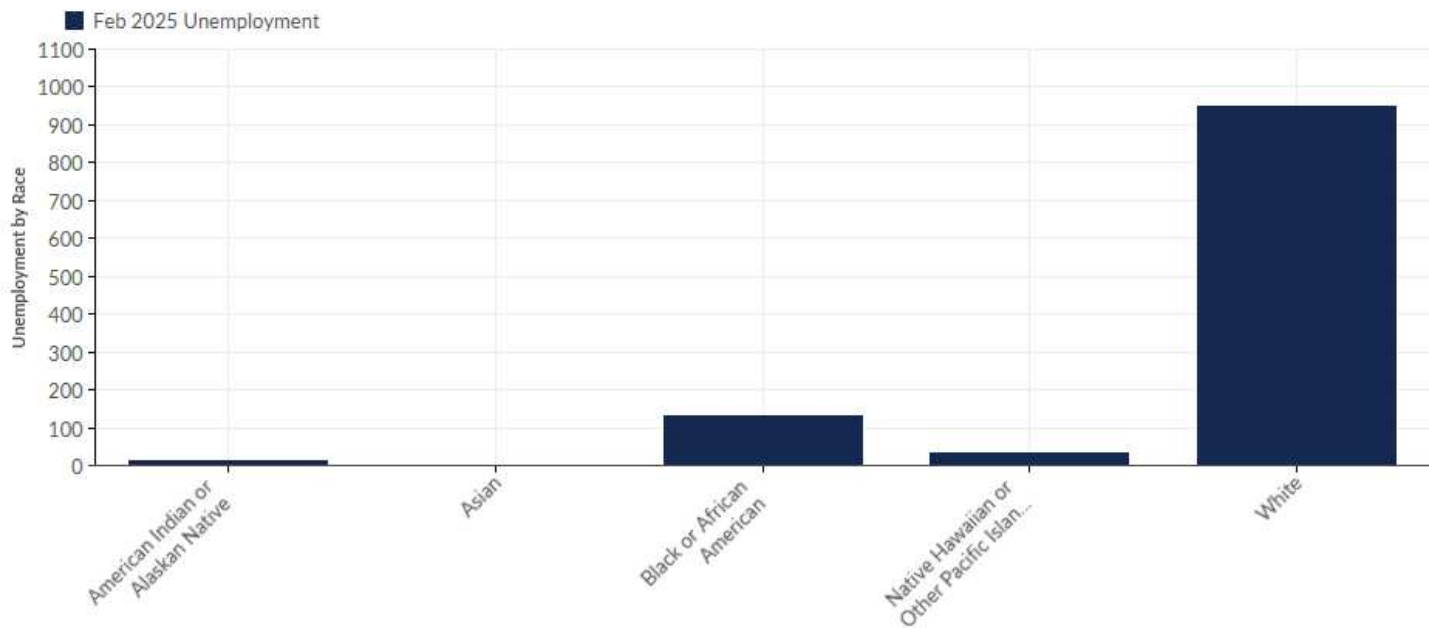

Unemployment by Gender



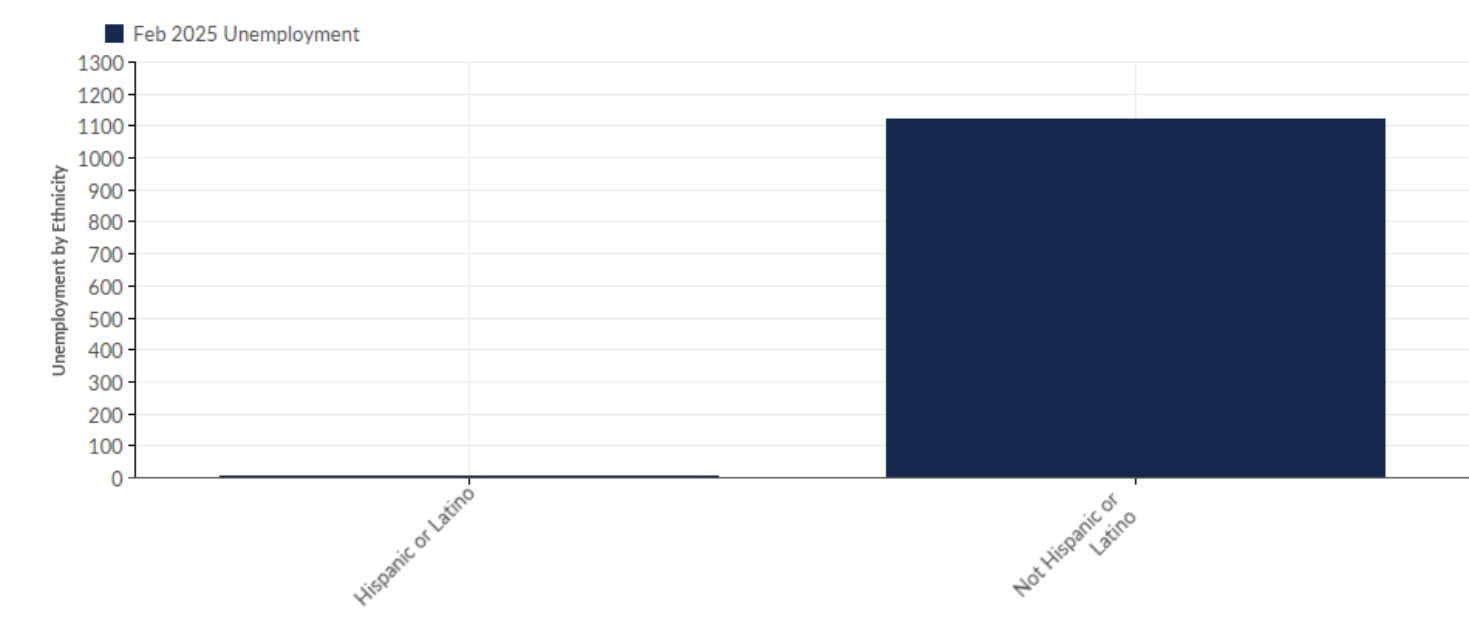

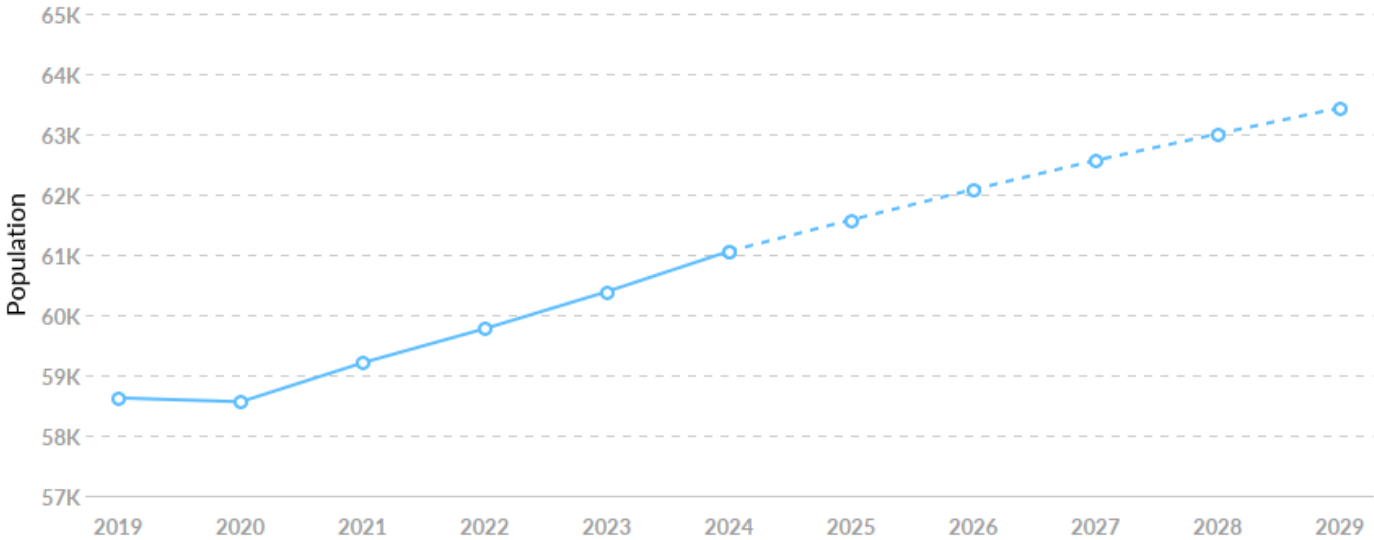

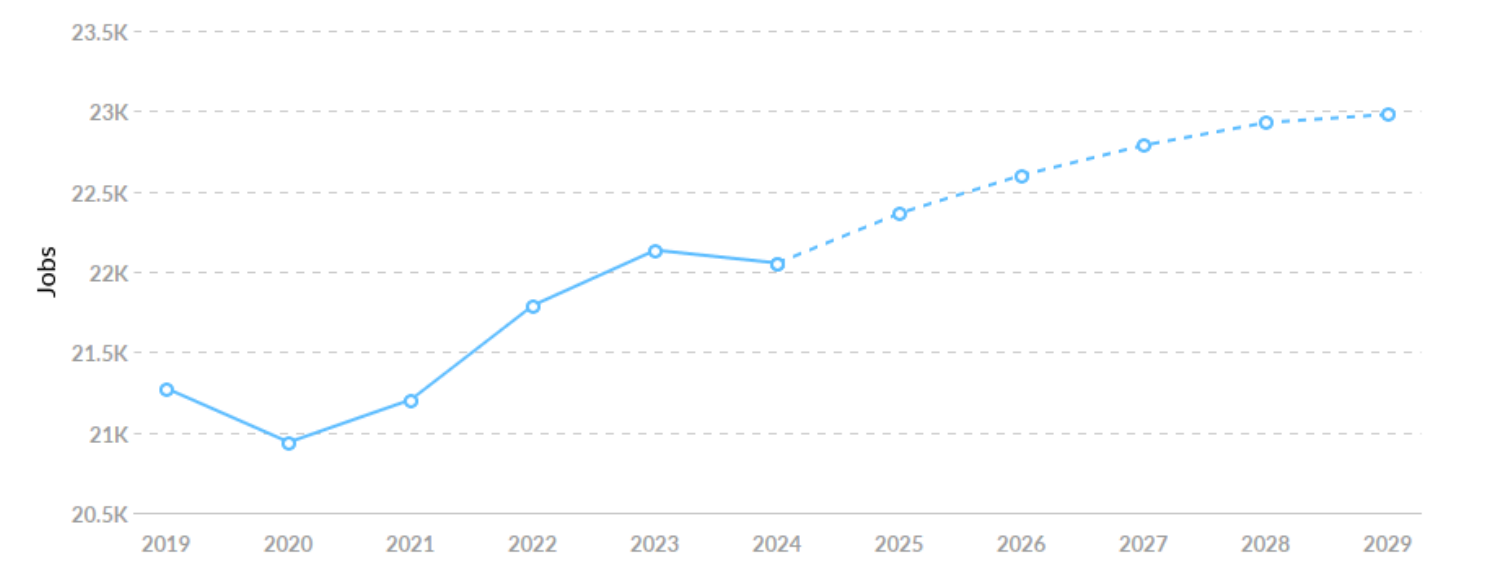

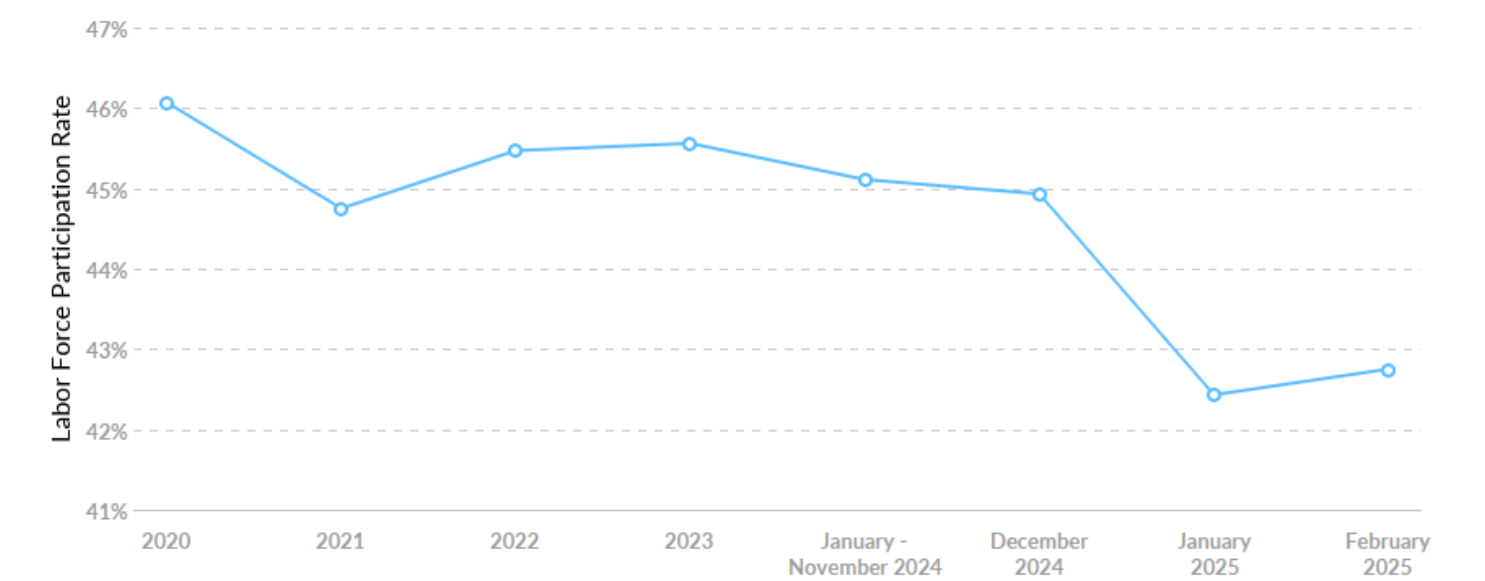
Job Trends

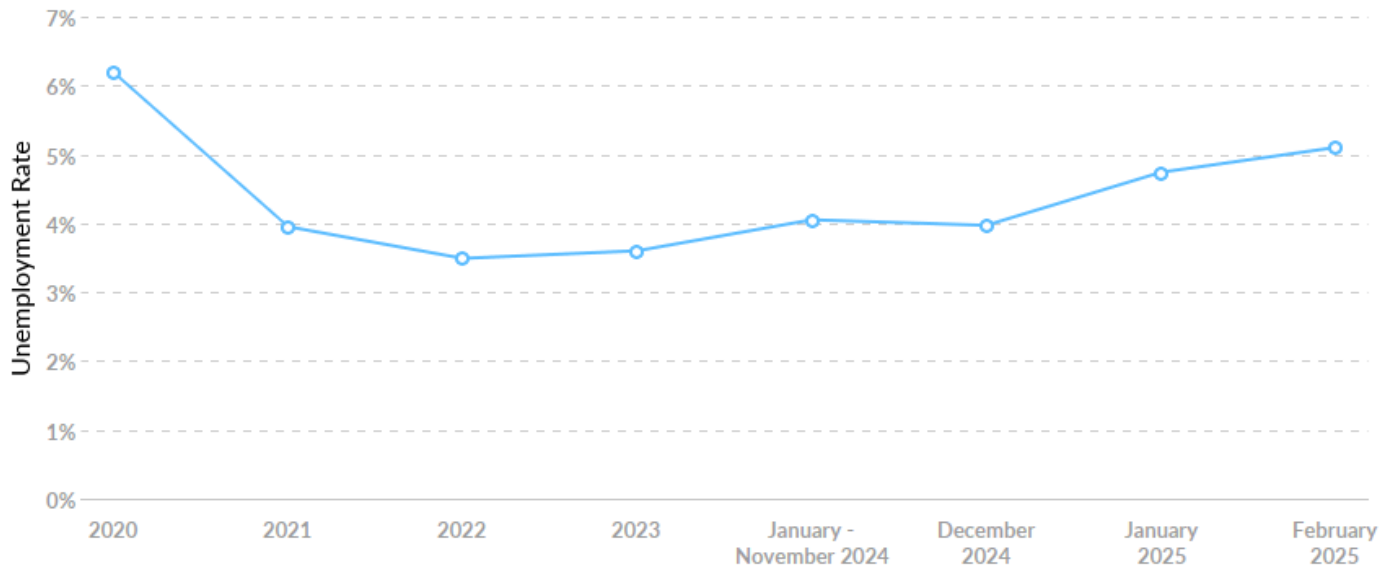

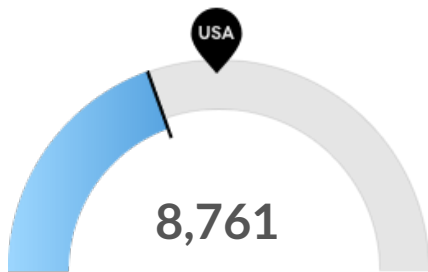

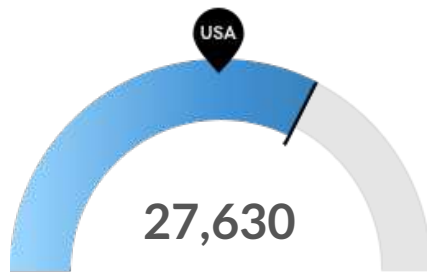

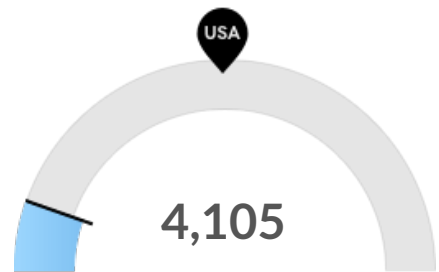
Millennials

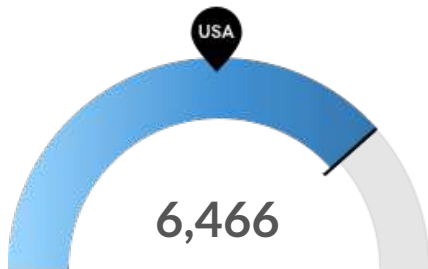
Retiring Soon

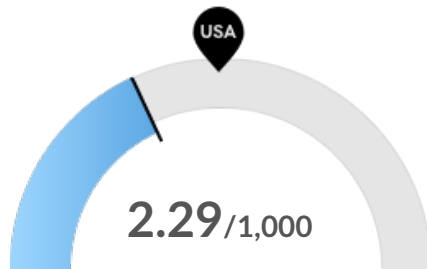

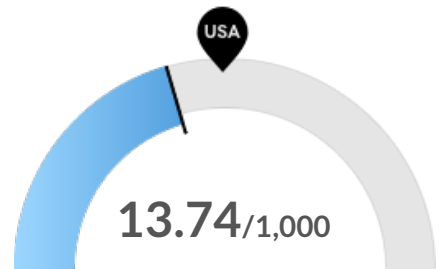

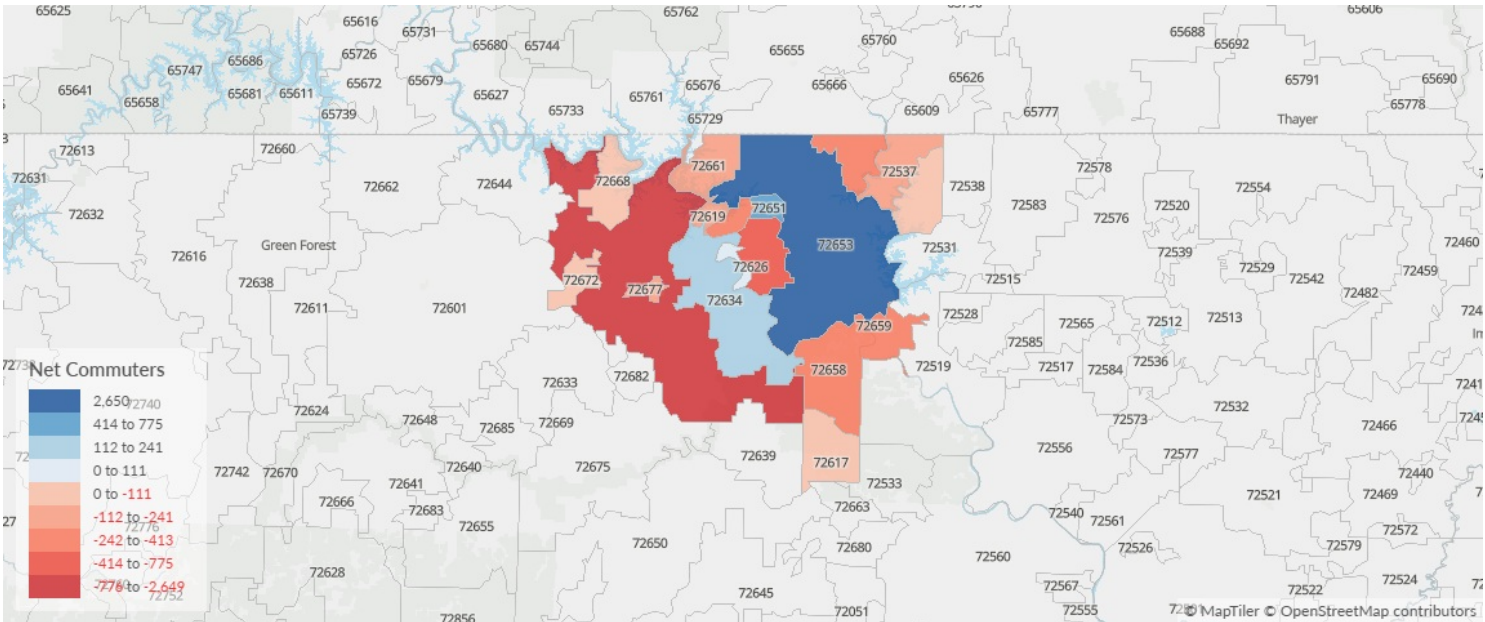

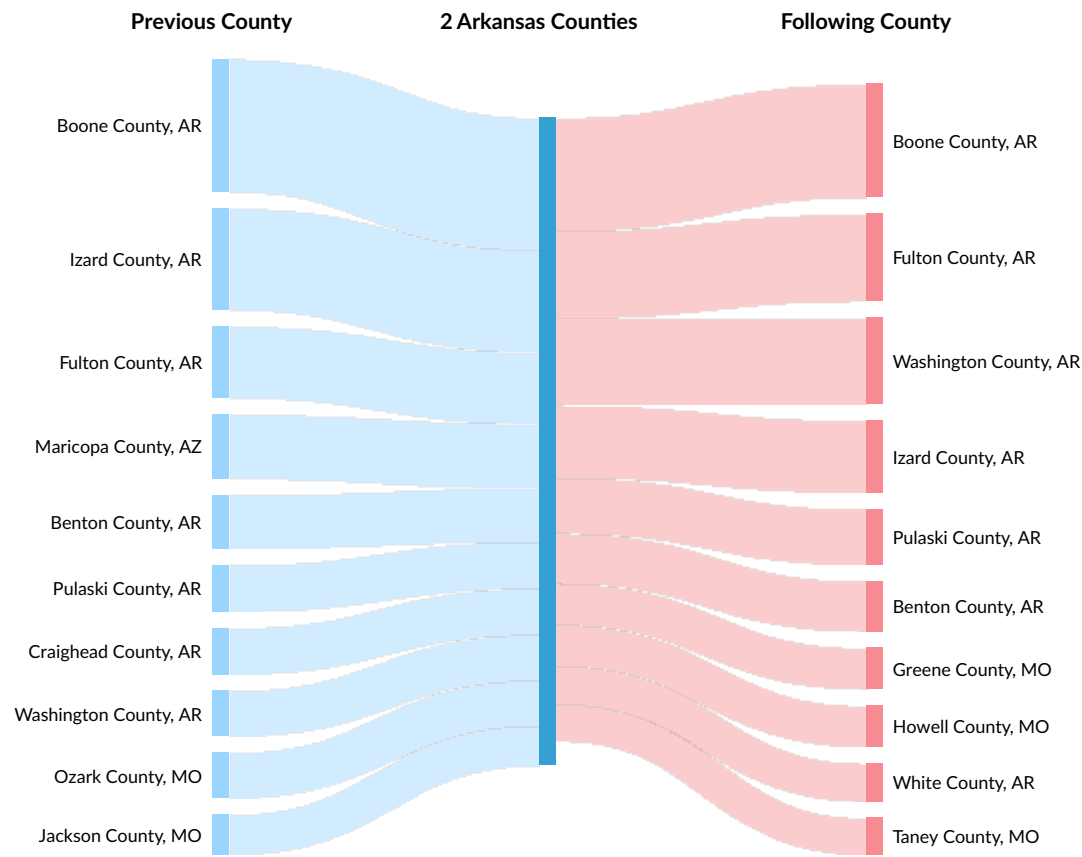

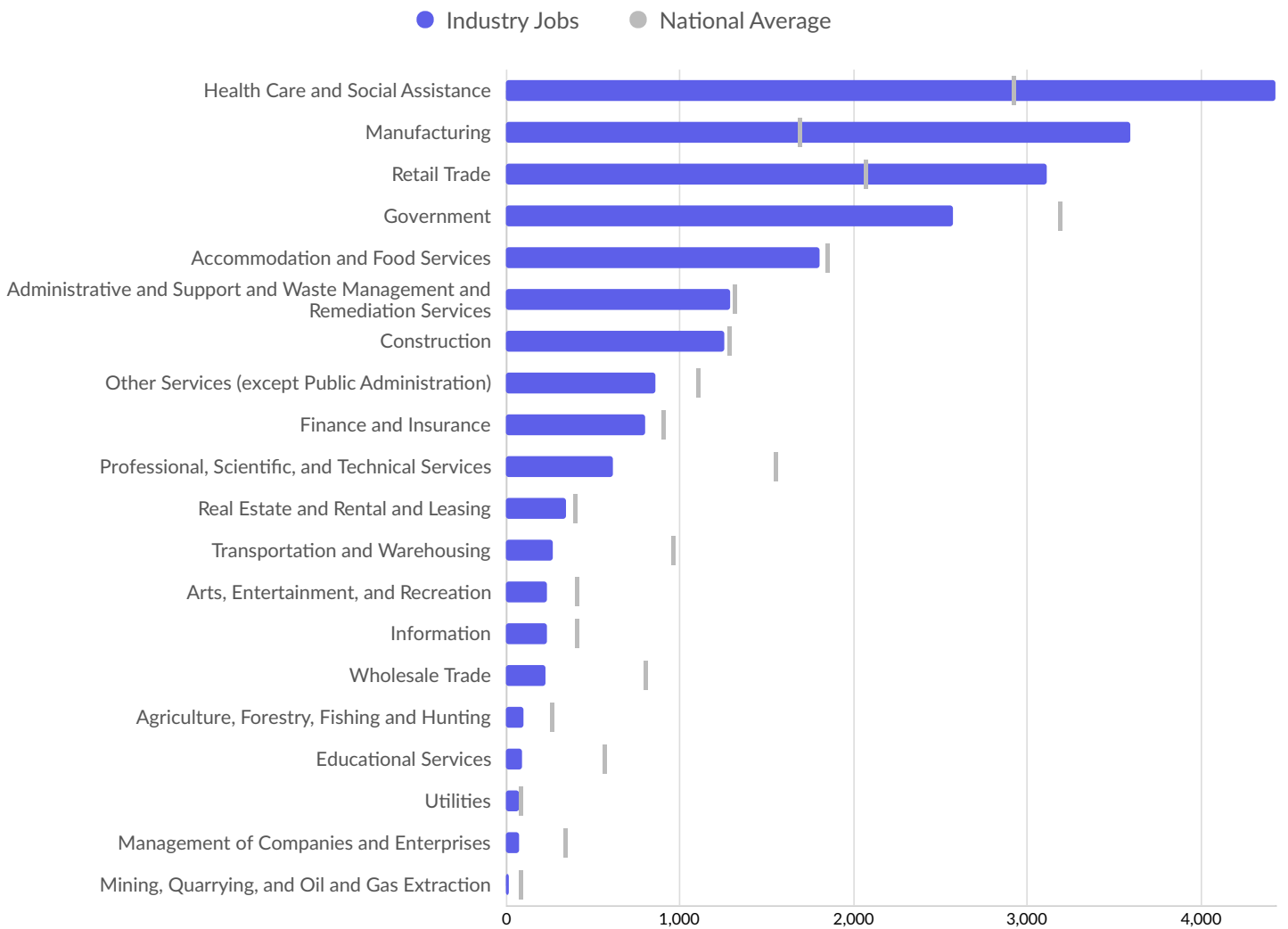

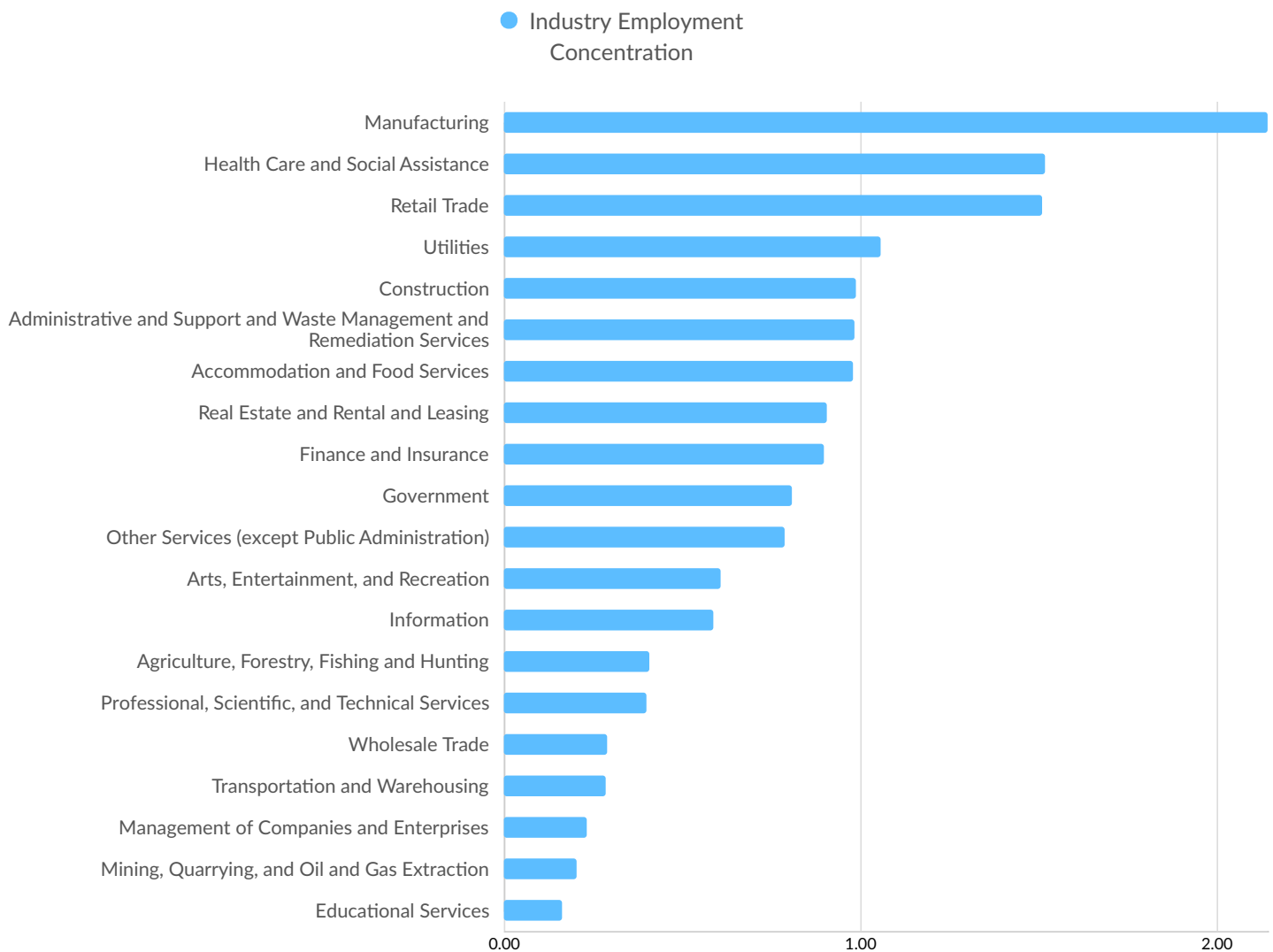

Top Growing Industries

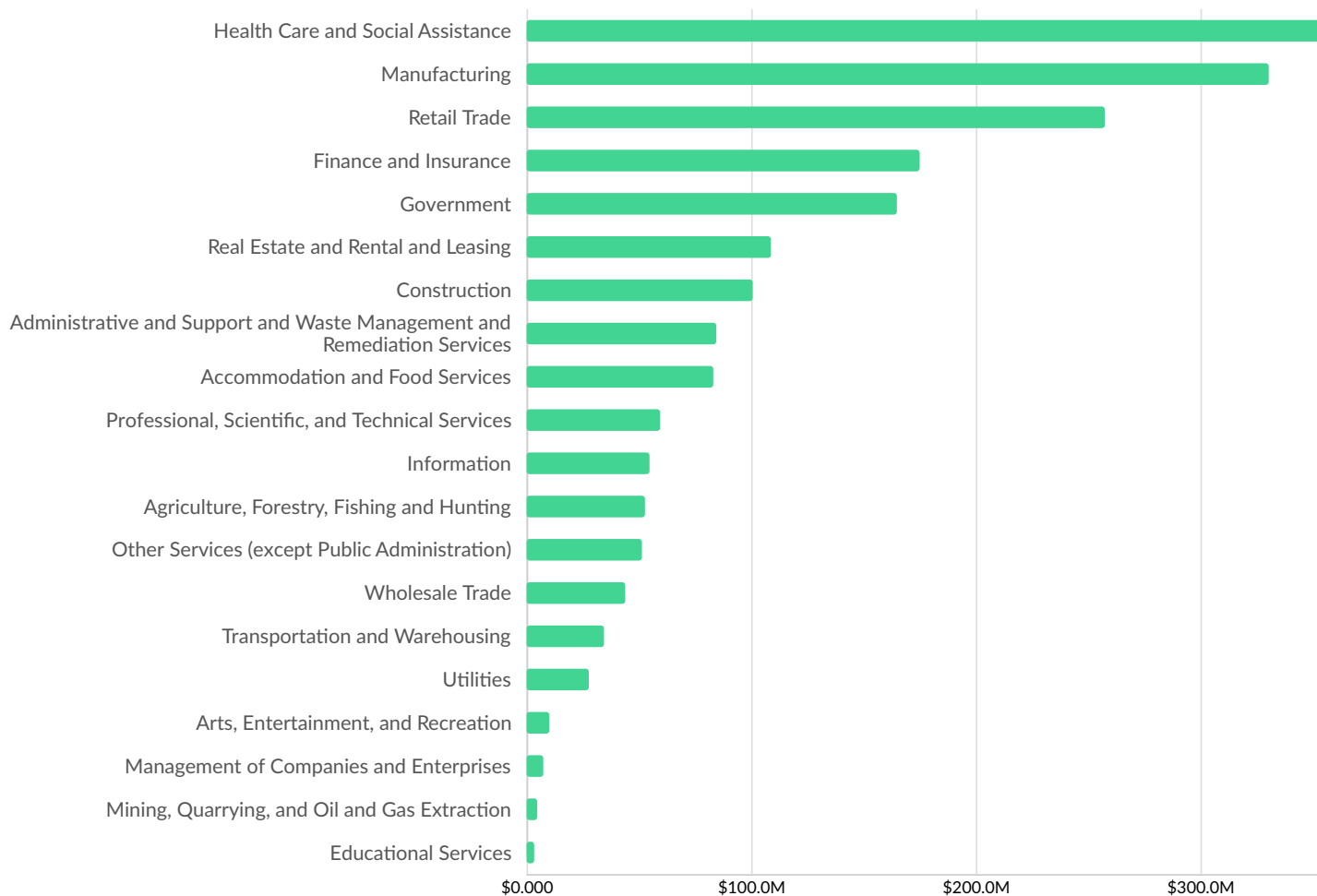


Top Industry Employment Concentration

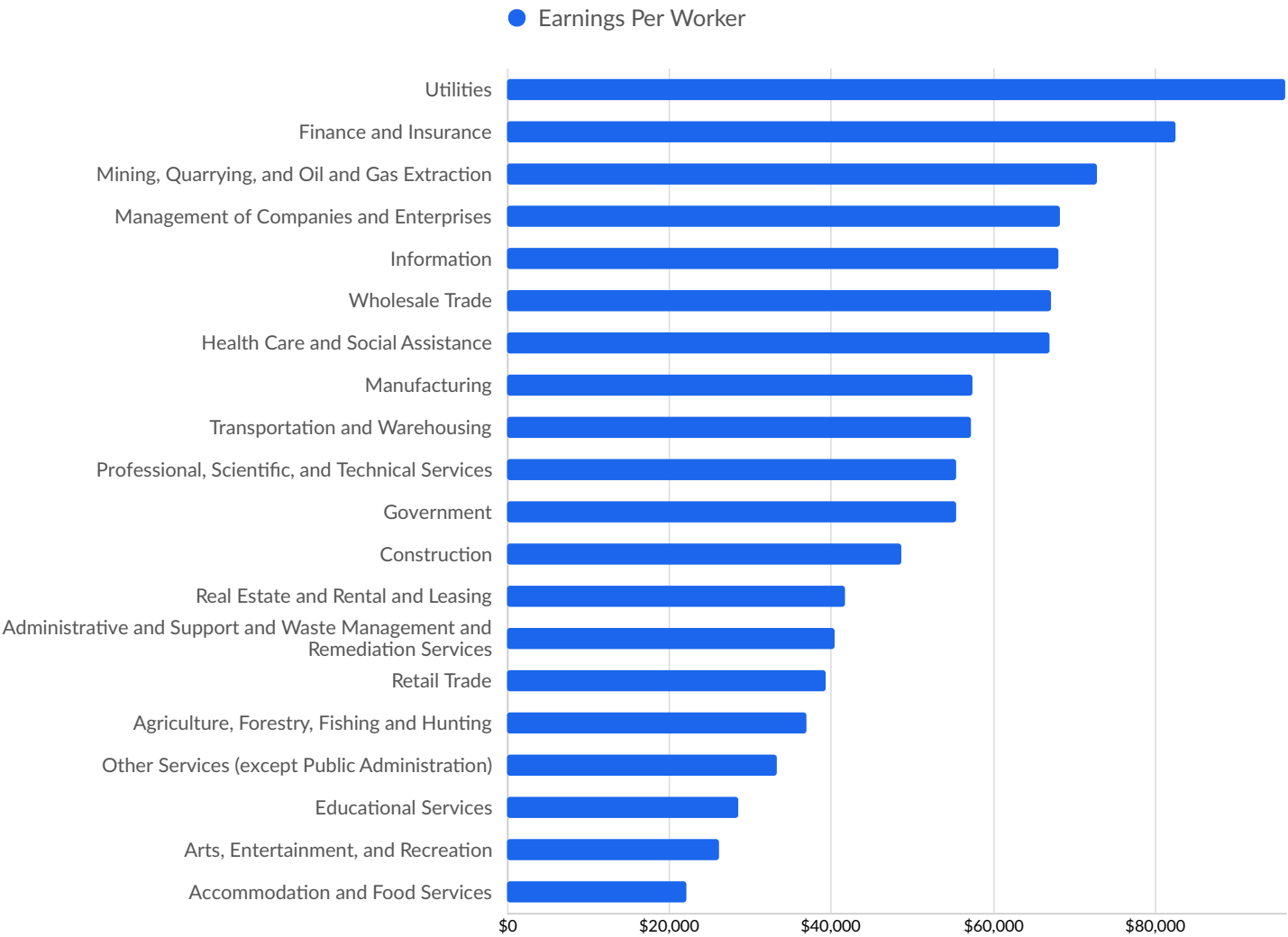


Top Industry GRP

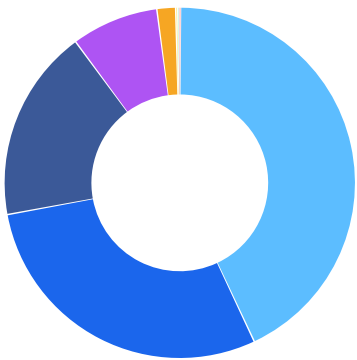

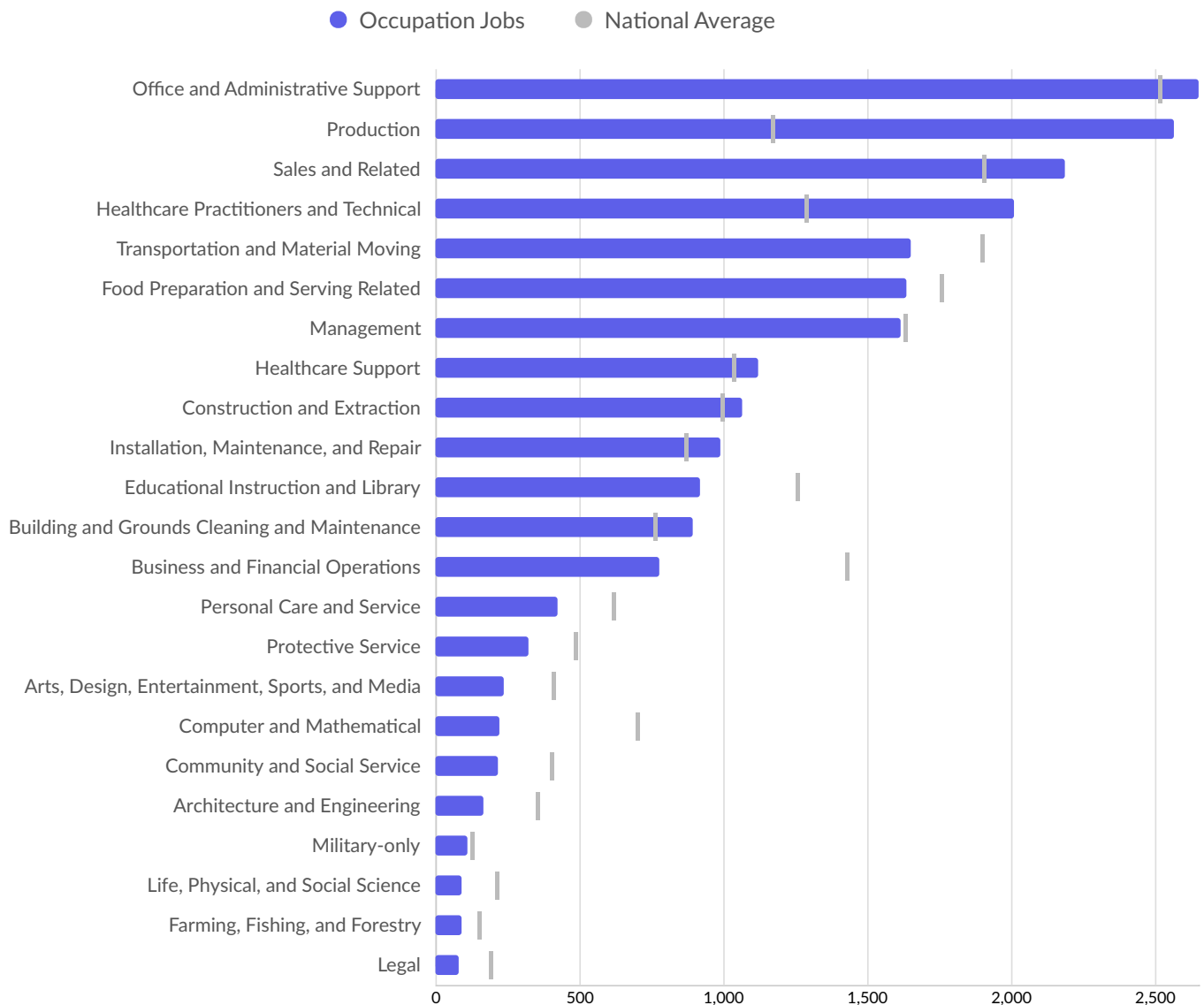

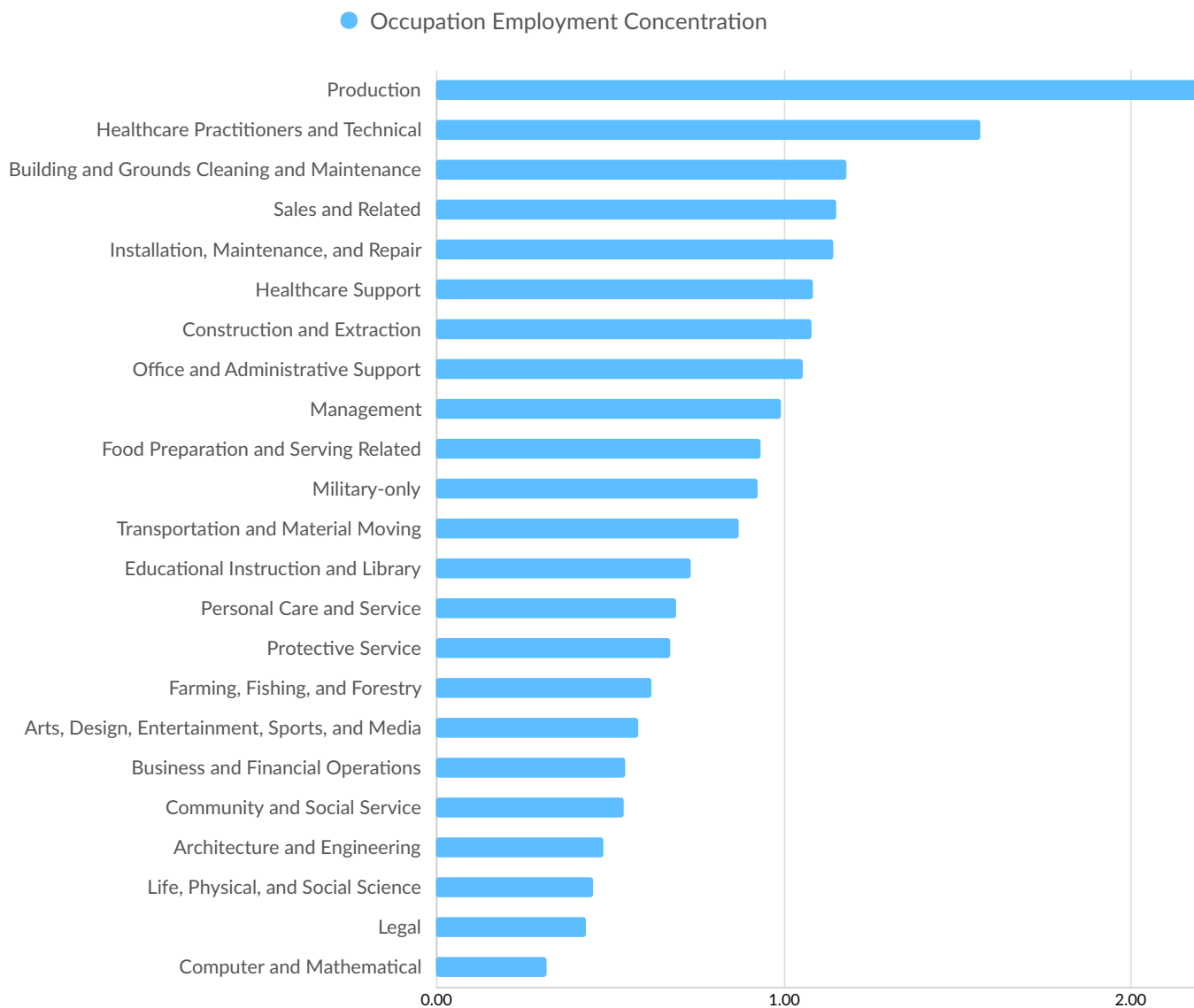

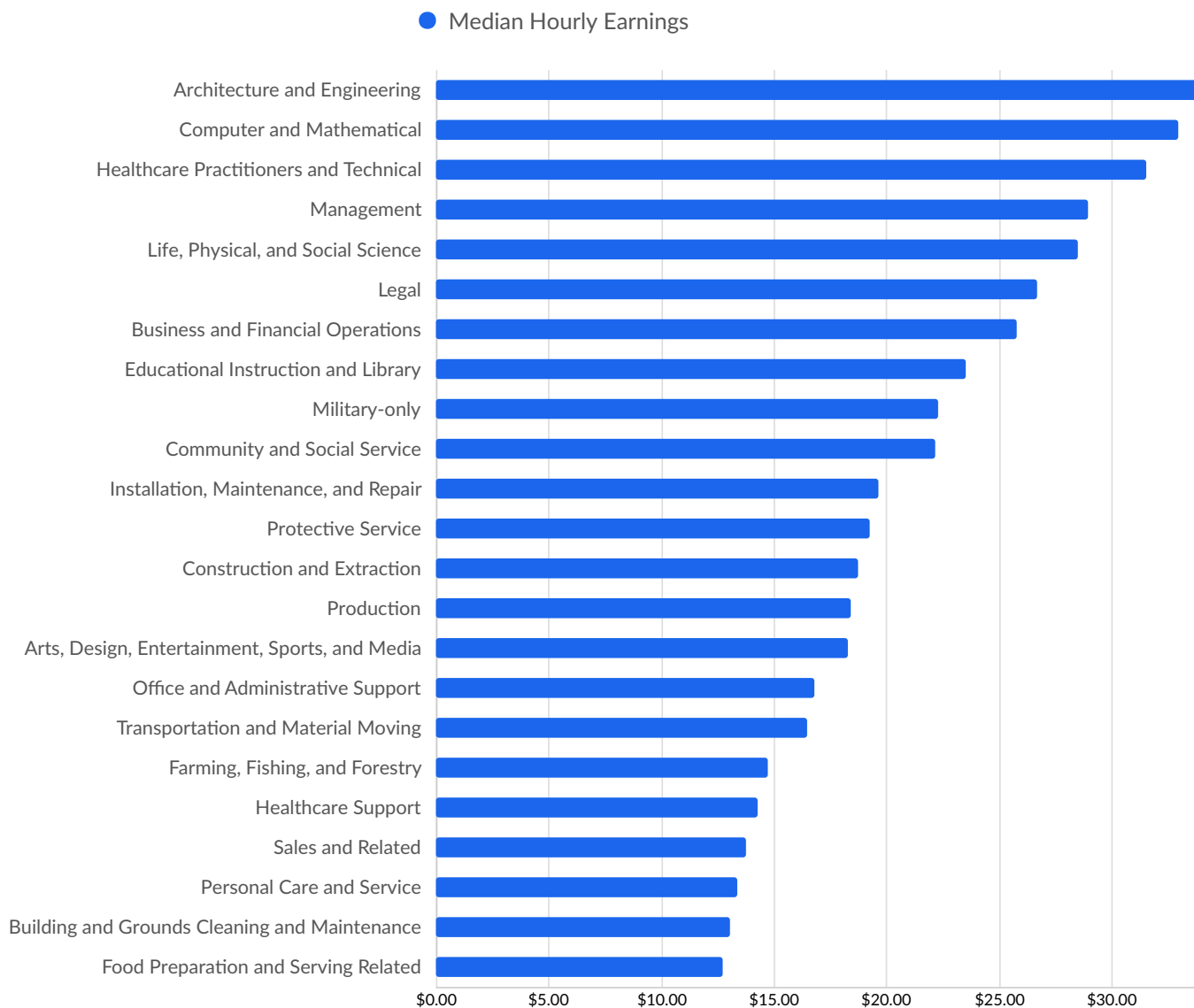
Top Growing Occupations



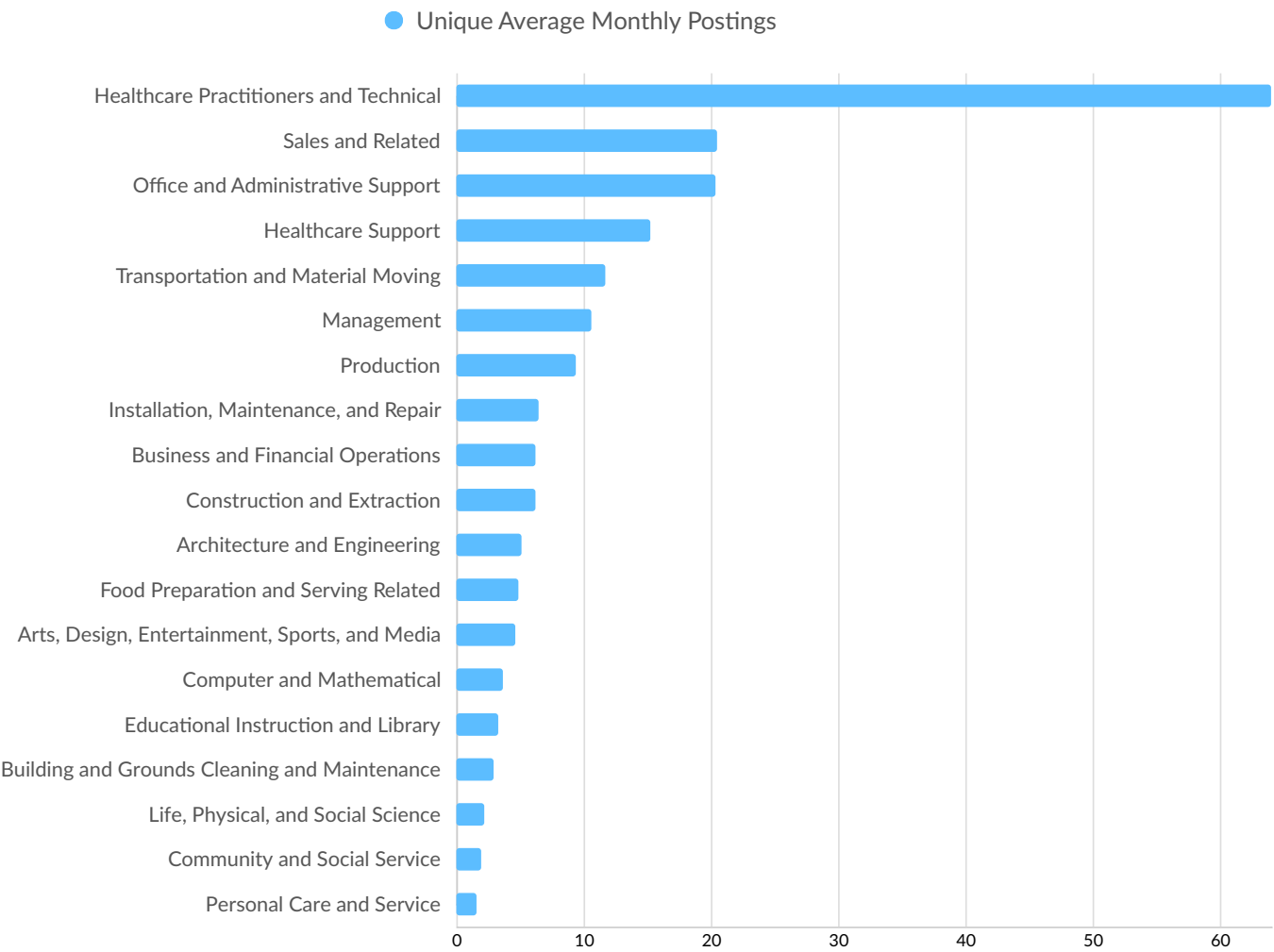
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



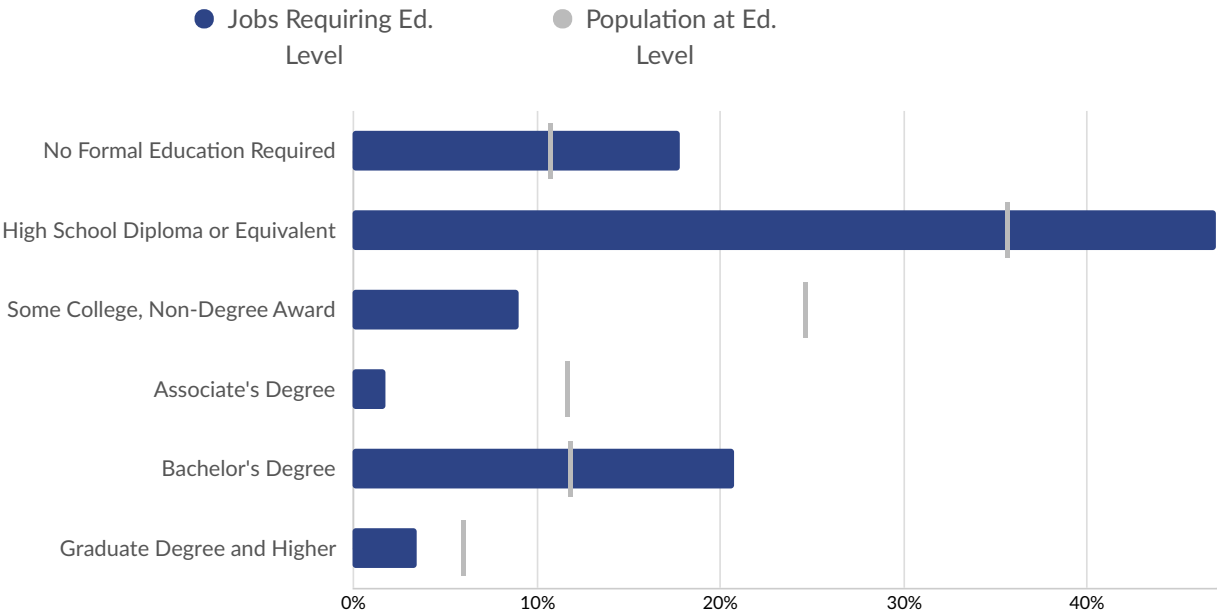
Top Occupation Earnings
