
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 4.2% since 2019, growing by 2,437. Population is expected to increase by 3.9% between 2024 and 2029, adding 2,380.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 3.7% in 2 Arkansas Counties from 21,273 to 22,054. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 0.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 46.4% to 44.9% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.7% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.7% below the national average), and **11.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).















### **Job Trends**




















### **Top Growing Industries**






### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**












### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**






