Takeaways

- As of 2018 the region's population **increased by 4.1**% since 2013, growing by 35,761. Population is expected to **increase by 3.2**% between 2018 and 2023, adding 28,870.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs increased by 7.7% in 18 Arkansas Counties from 355,018 to 382,270. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 0.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 54.5% to 54.8% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.6% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.1% below the national average), and **6.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.5% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Management of Companies and Enterprises, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).




Unemployment Rate Trends














Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP



Educational Pipeline

In 2017, there were 11,652 graduates in 18 Arkansas Counties. This pipeline has remained stable (neither grown nor shrunk) over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from Liberal Arts and Sciences/Liberal Studies, General Studies, and Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide.
