- From 2013 to 2018, jobs increased by 7.2% in 4 Arkansas Counties from 48,998 to 52,516. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 1.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 56.2% to 56.2% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.8% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.8% below the national average), and **7.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.5% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.














#### **Top Growing Industries**






#### Top Industry LQ




