

- From 2013 to 2018, jobs declined by 3.8% in 6 Arkansas Counties from 29,109 to 28,010. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 12.0%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 49.7% to 47.6% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **7.0% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (11.6% below the national average), and **5.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Crop Production, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.






#### **Top Growing Industries**






