- From 2013 to 2018, jobs increased by 1.1% in 4 Arkansas Counties from 32,295 to 32,666. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 7.1%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 48.6% to 47.2% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **9.1% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.5% below the national average), and **7.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.9% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.





## **Labor Force Participation Rate Trends**


















### **Top Growing Industries**






### Top Industry LQ










