
Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population declined by 2.0% since 2019, falling by 323. Population is expected to increase by 0.7% between 2024 and 2029, adding 114.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 16.5% in Van Buren County, AR from 4,190 to 4,880. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 12.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 41.9% to 44.8% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.9% of Van Buren County, AR residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.6% below the national average), and **7.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.7% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Private Households, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Nursing Care Facilities (Skilled Nursing Facilities).






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Van Buren County, AR had a February 2025 unemployment rate of 5.70%, decreasing from 7.25% 5 years before.




Millennials

Van Buren County, AR has 2,193 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,280.




Veterans

Van Buren County, AR has 1,275 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 823.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Van Buren County, AR. The national average for an area this size is 4,873 people 55 or older, while there are 6,888 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Van Buren County, AR. The national average for an area this size is 6,723 racially diverse people, while there are 1,239 here.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP








Top Occupation Employment Concentration




