Median household income is \$17.6K below the national median household income of \$57.7K.


Takeaways

- As of 2018 the region's population **increased by 0.9%** since 2013, growing by 381. Population is expected to **increase by 0.6%** between 2018 and 2023, adding 268.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs increased by 4.7% in Baxter County, AR from 15,853 to 16,600. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 3.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 45.7% to 46.8% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.2% of Baxter County, AR residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.5% below the national average), and **8.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Medical Equipment and Supplies Manufacturing.






Unemployment Rate Trends

Baxter County, AR had a January 2019 unemployment rate of 5.30%, decreasing from 6.68% 5 years before.





Baxter County, AR has 5,602 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 8,566.




Baxter County, AR has 4,644 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 2.405.




Retiring Soon

Property Crime


Baxter County, AR has 32.37 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 24.21 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP




