
- As of 2018 the region's population increased by 4.9% since 2013, growing by 5,811. Population is expected to increase by 4.2% between 2018 and 2023, adding 5,212.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs increased by 1.1% in Faulkner County, AR from 46,542 to 47,069. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 7.1%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.4% to 60.8% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.4% of Faulkner County, AR residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (0.2% below the national average), and **6.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.







### **Labor Force Participation Rate Trends**






### **Unemployment Rate Trends**

Faulkner County, AR had a January 2019 unemployment rate of 3.83%, decreasing from 5.55% 5 years before.








Millennials

Faulkner County, AR has 32,553 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 25,610.




Faulkner County, AR has 7,352 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 7.190.




**Retiring Soon**

**Property Crime** 


Faulkner County, AR has 36.89 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 24.21 per 1,000 people.






#### Top Industry LQ






#### **Top Industry GRP**










