Population grew by 110 over the last 5 years and is projected to grow by 262 over the next 5 years.

- As of 2018 the region's population increased by 0.3% since 2013, growing by 110. Population is expected to increase by 0.8% between 2018 and 2023, adding 262.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs increased by 2.1% in Hot Spring County, AR from 9,422 to 9,618. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 6.1%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 50.7% to 49.3% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.8% of Hot Spring County, AR residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.8% below the national average), and **8.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Business Support Services.







Labor Force Participation Rate Trends






Unemployment Rate Trends

Hot Spring County, AR had a January 2019 unemployment rate of 4.33%, decreasing from 5.77% 5 years before.






Millennials

Hot Spring County, AR has 2,410 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,952.




Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is low in Hot Spring County, AR. The national average for an area this size is 13,185 racially diverse people, while there are 5,786 here.








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP





Educational Pipeline

In 2017, there were 632 graduates in Hot Spring County, AR. This pipeline has grown by 4% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from Registered Nursing/Registered Nurse, Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide, and Liberal Arts and Sciences/Liberal Studies.
