- From 2013 to 2018, jobs increased by 2.0% in Madison County, AR from 3,932 to 4,011. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 6.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 54.0% to 56.2% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **7.3% of Madison County, AR residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (11.3% below the national average), and **5.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Animal Slaughtering and Processing, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and General Merchandise Stores, including Warehouse Clubs and Supercenters.







Madison County, AR had a January 2019 unemployment rate of 3.34%, decreasing from 4.83% 5 years before.






Millennials

Madison County, AR has 2,790 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 3,384.




Veterans

Madison County, AR has 969 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 950.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Madison County, AR. The national average for an area this size is 4,658 people 55 or older, while there are 5,427 here.




Racial Diversity

Property Crime









Top Growing Industries






Top Industry GRP







Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation Earnings


Top Posted Occupations
