- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 6.8% since 2019, growing by 1,136. Population is expected to increase by 5.4% between 2024 and 2029, adding 957.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 11.4% in Marion County, AR from 4,529 to 4,011. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 15.3%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 47.3% to 39.8% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.7% of Marion County**, **AR residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (12.8% below the national average), and **8.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (the same as the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Ship and Boat Building, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Plastics Product Manufacturing.











Unemployment by Ethnicity












Marion County, AR had a February 2025 unemployment rate of 6.70%, increasing from 6.54% 5 years before.

Millennials


Marion County, AR has 2,429 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,559.






Veterans

Marion County, AR has 1,760 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 884.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Marion County, AR. The national average for an area this size is 5,287 people 55 or older, while there are 8,050 here.




Violent Crime

Marion County, AR has 3.2 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Marion County, AR. The national average for an area this size is 7,294 racially diverse people, while there are 1,258 here.




Property Crime





Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP










Top Occupation Employment Concentration




