- From 2013 to 2018, jobs declined by 1.2% in Nevada County, AR from 2,746 to 2,713. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 9.4%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate increased from 53.8% to 53.9% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **9.2% of Nevada County, AR residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.4% below the national average), and **6.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Rubber Product Manufacturing, Gasoline Stations, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).






Job Trends




Unemployment Rate Trends

Nevada County, AR had a January 2019 unemployment rate of 4.19%, decreasing from 6.04% 5 years before.






Millennials

Nevada County, AR has 1,344 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 1,725.




Veterans

Nevada County, AR has 441 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 484.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Nevada County, AR. The national average for an area this size is 2,374 people 55 or older, while there are 2,921 here.




Racial Diversity










Top Industry GRP






Top Growing Occupations



Occupation Jobs Growth




Top Occupation Earnings


Top Posted Occupations
