Median household income is **\$17.0K below** the national median household income of \$57.7K.

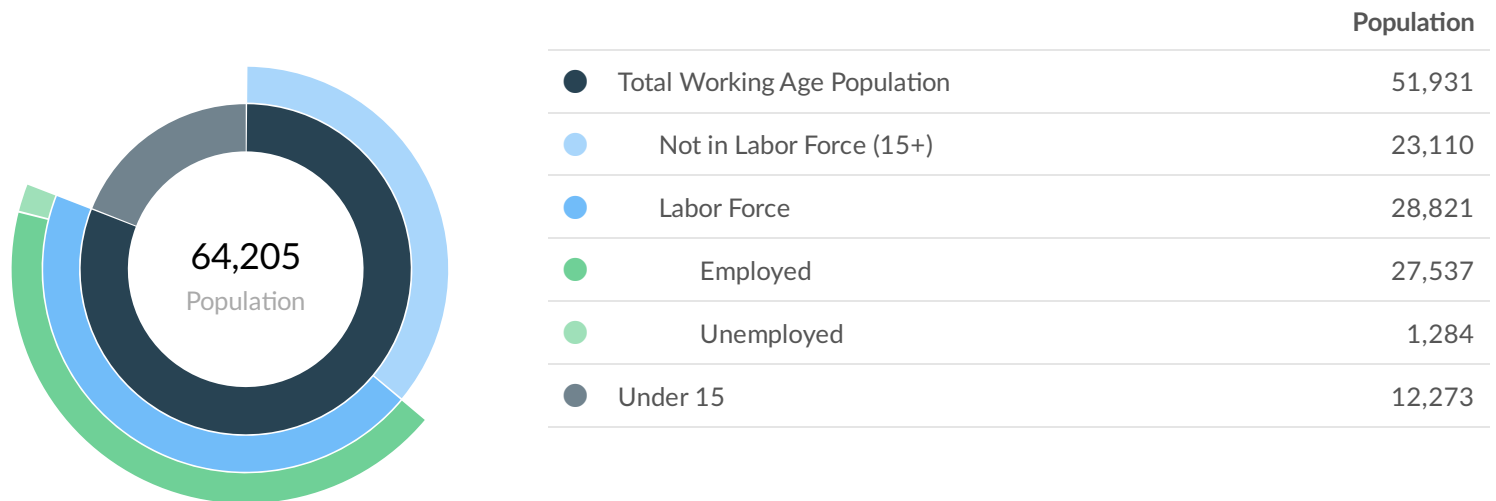
Takeaways

- As of 2018 the region's population **increased by 2.7%** since 2013, growing by 1,669. Population is expected to **increase by 1.7%** between 2018 and 2023, adding 1,114.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs **declined by 2.6%** in Pope County, AR from 29,310 to **28,556**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 10.8%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 57.6% to 55.5% between 2013 and 2018**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.9% of Pope County, AR residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.7% below the national average), and **4.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (State Government), and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).

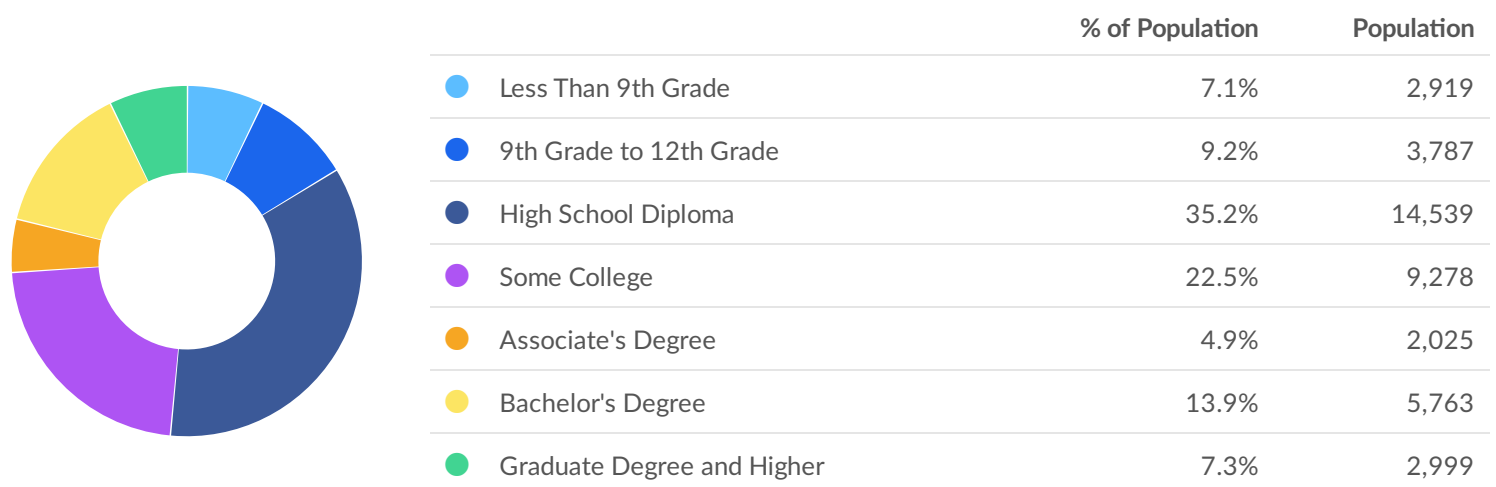

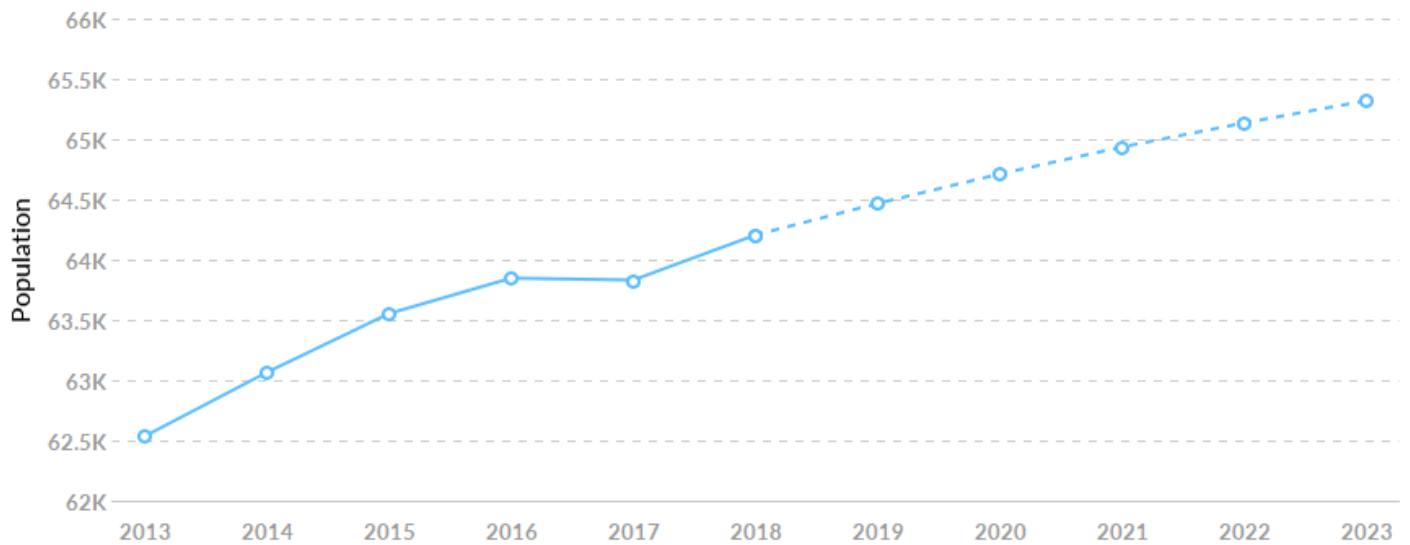

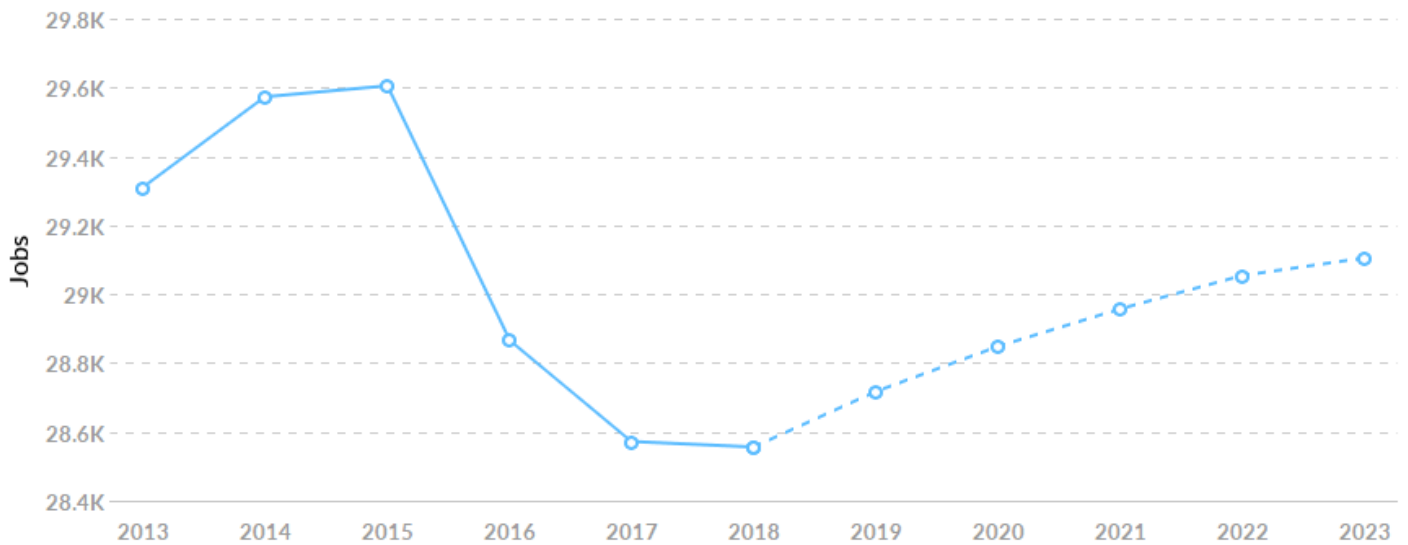

Job Trends

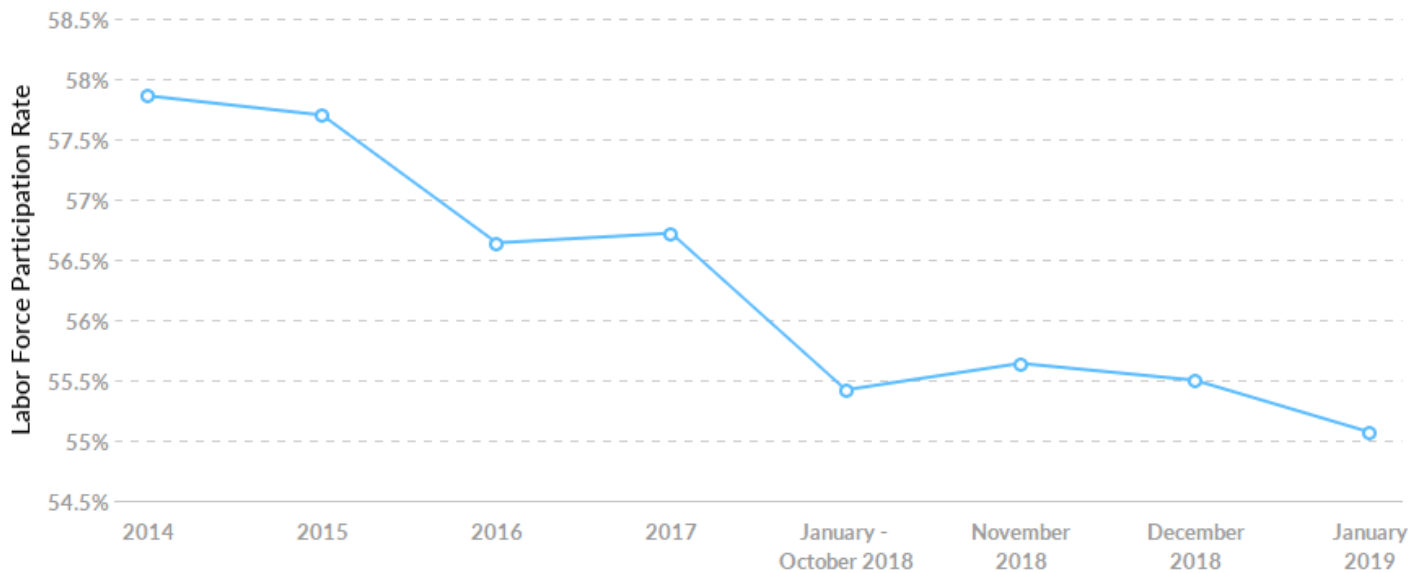

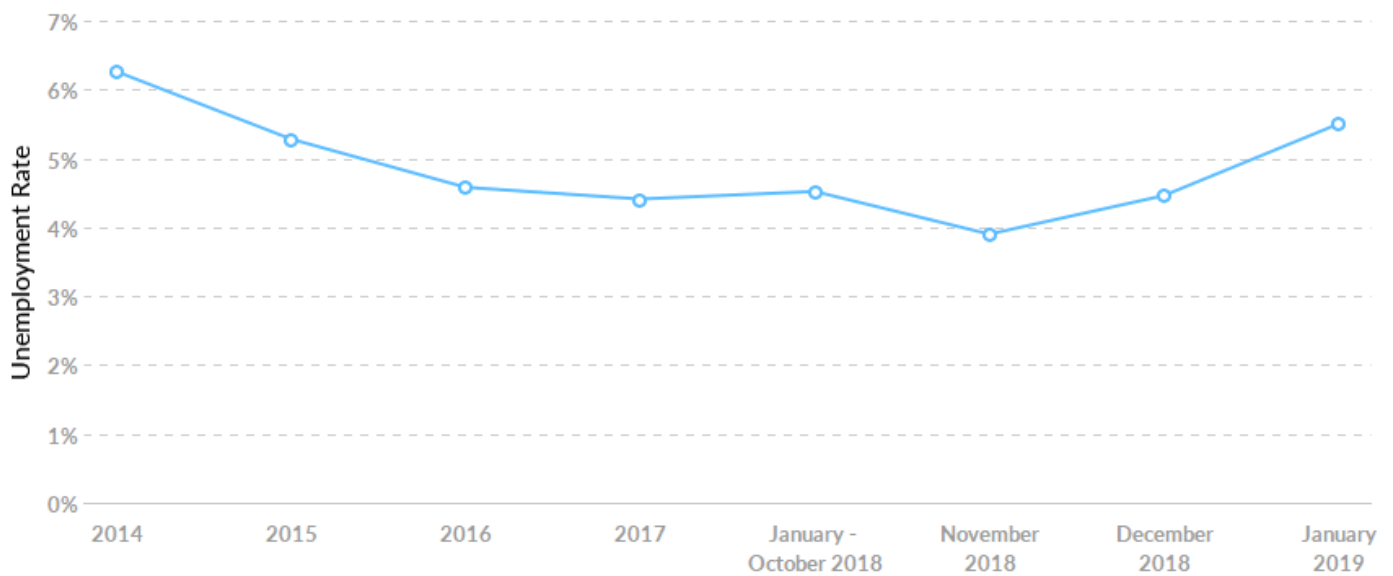

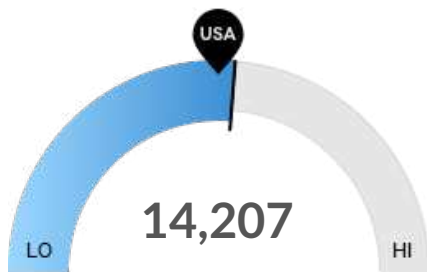
Unemployment Rate Trends

Pope County, AR had a January 2019 unemployment rate of 5.50%, **decreasing from 6.26%** 5 years before.



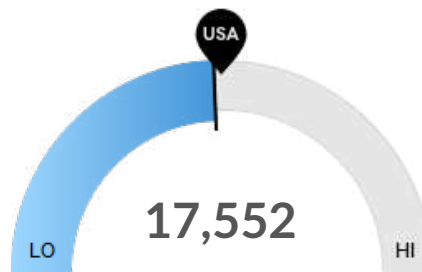

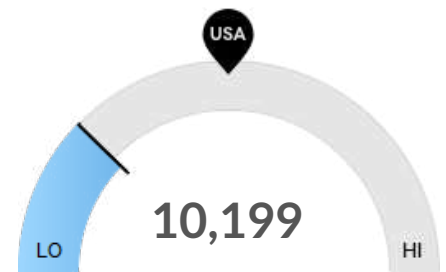
Millennials

Pope County, AR has 14,207 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 13,220.



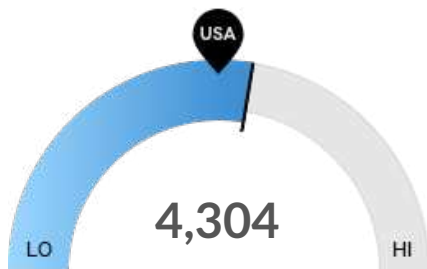
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Pope County, AR. The national average for an area this size is 18,197 people 55 or older, while there are 17,552 here.



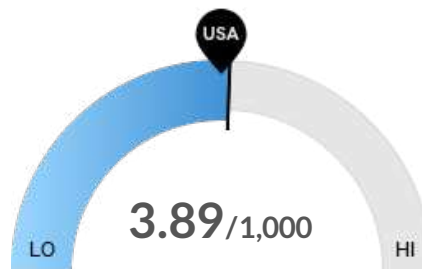
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Pope County, AR. The national average for an area this size is 25,068 racially diverse people, while there are 10,199 here.



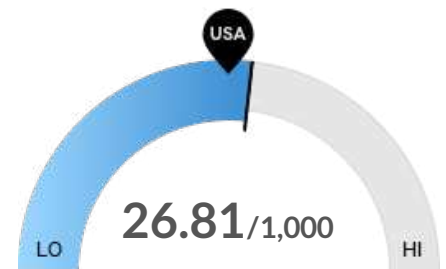
Veterans

Pope County, AR has 3.89 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.75 per 1,000 people.



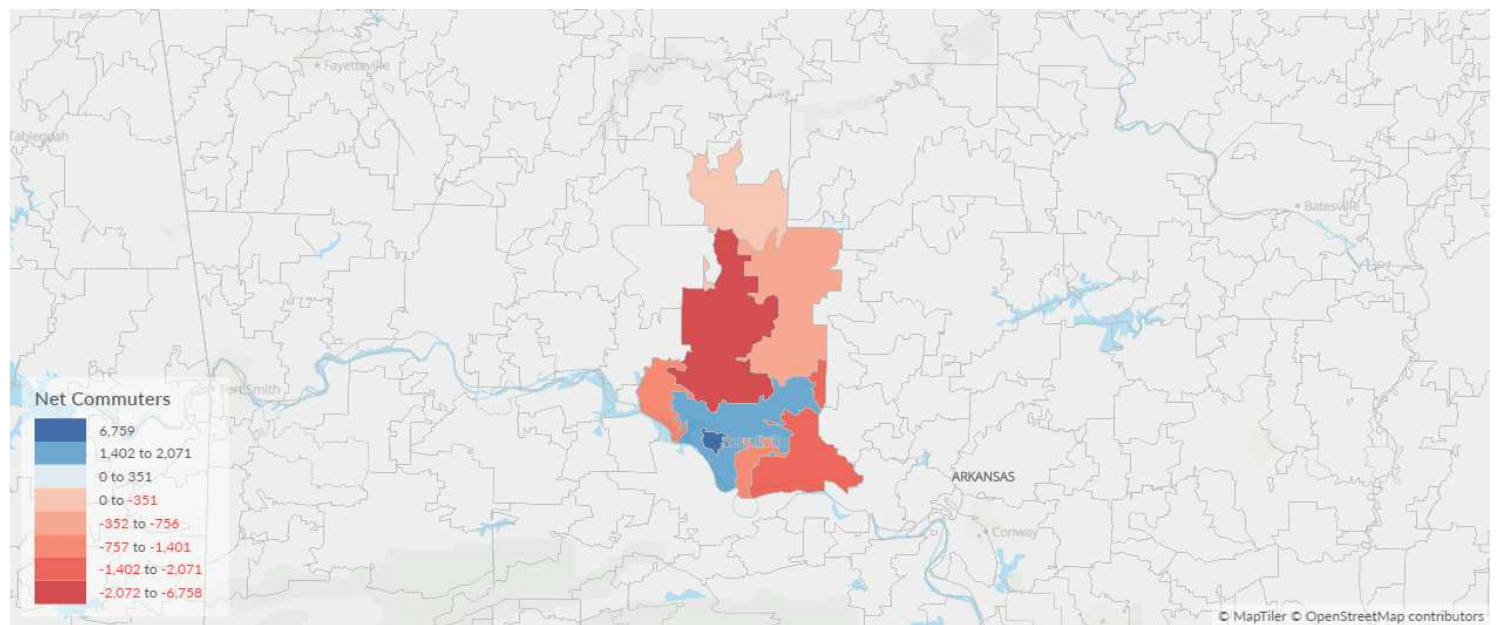
Property Crime

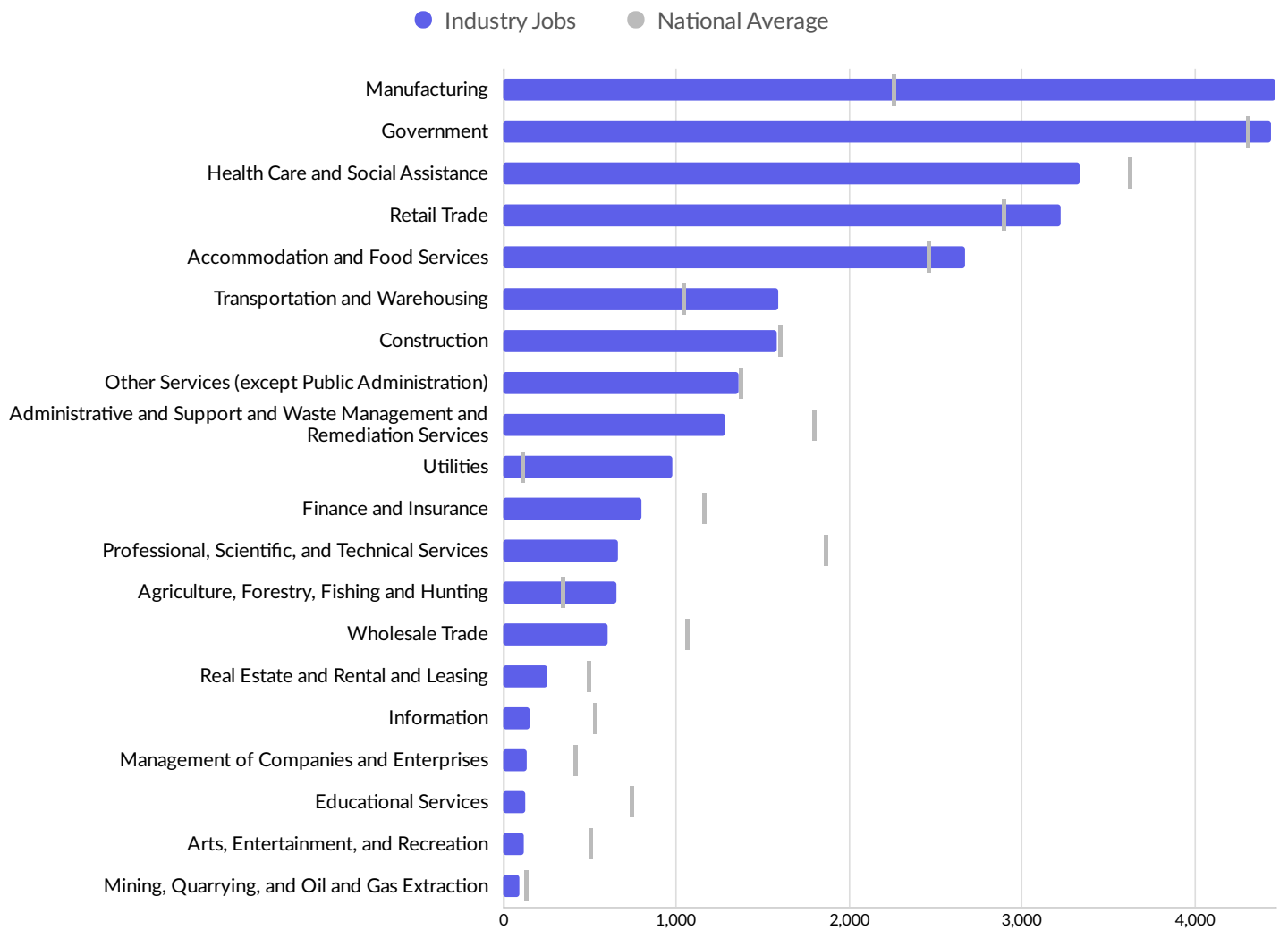

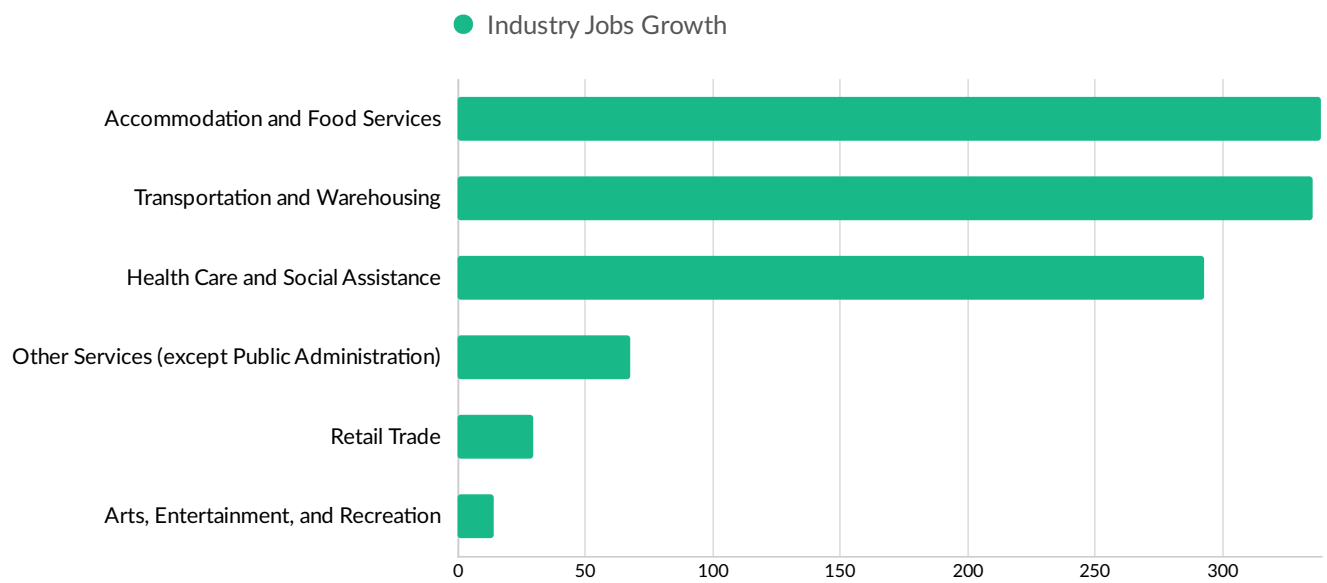

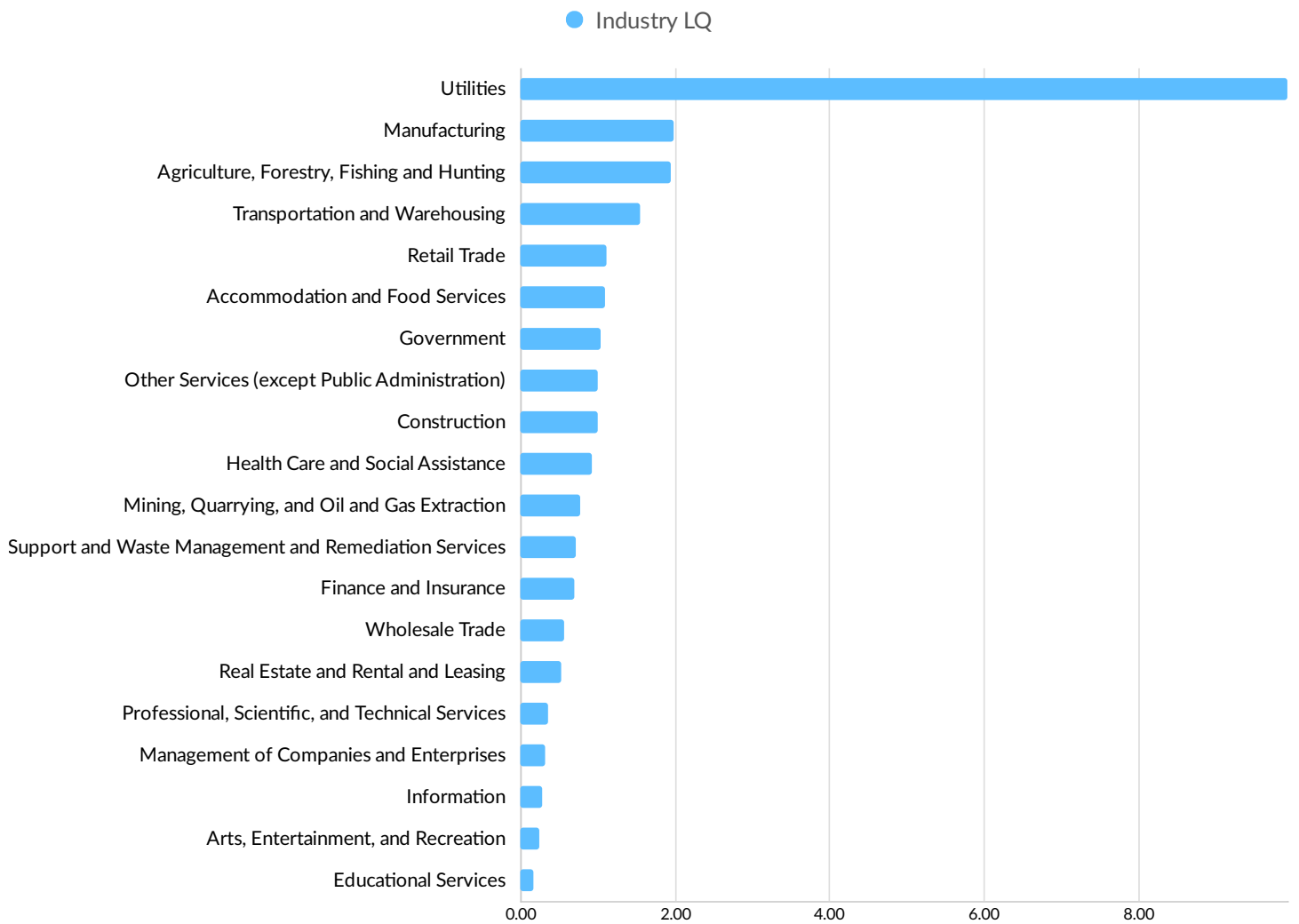

Top Growing Industries



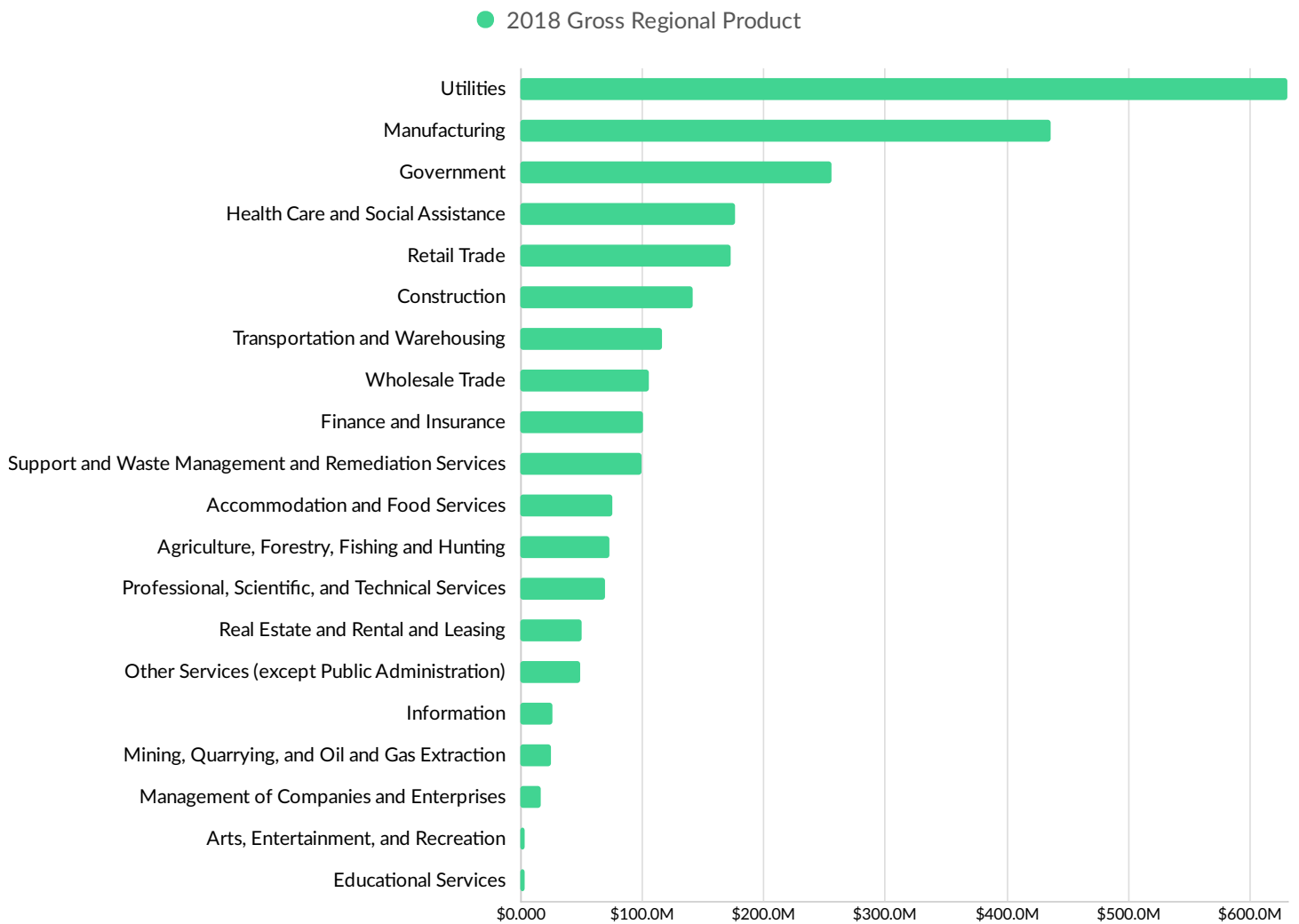

Top Industry LQ



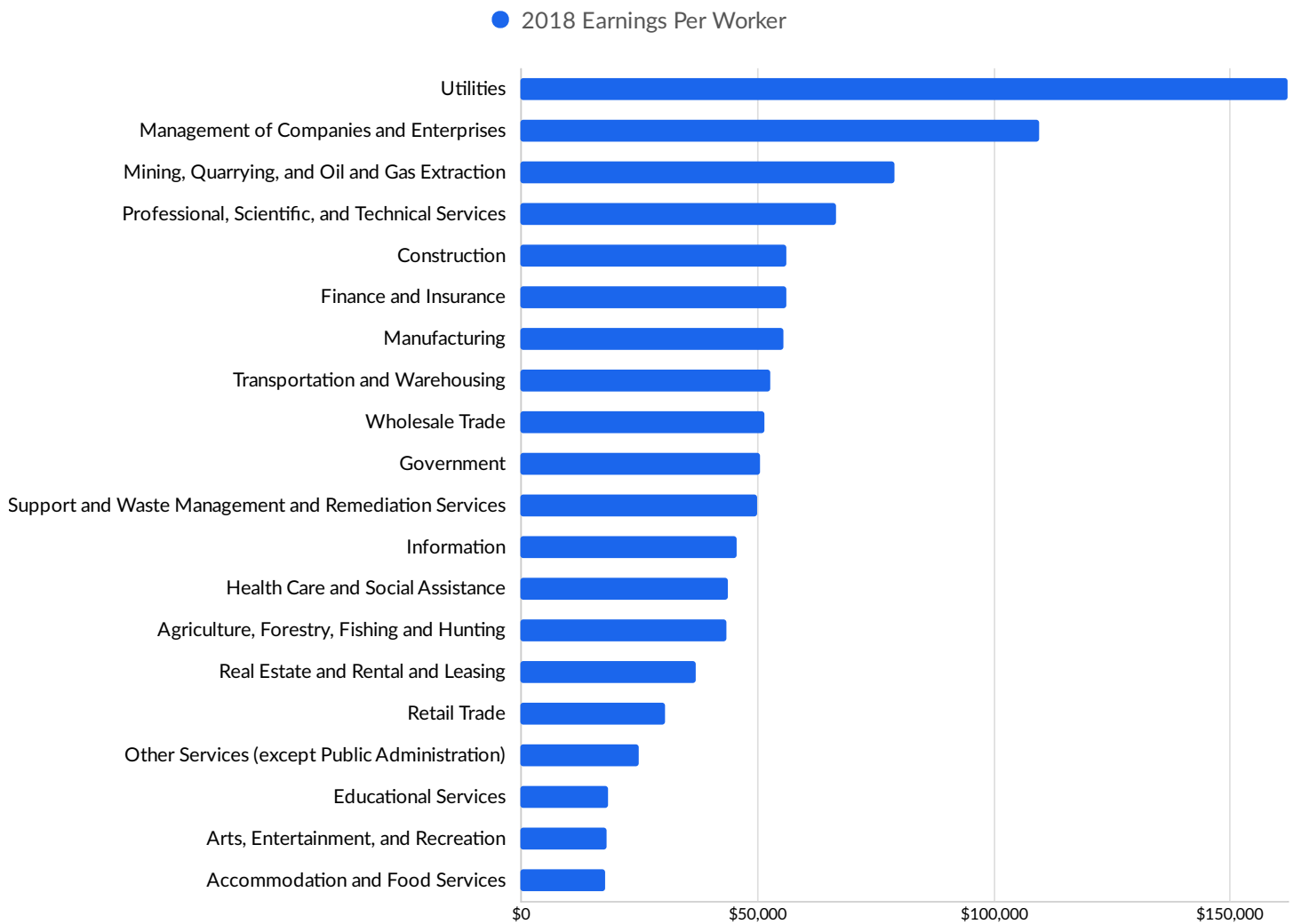

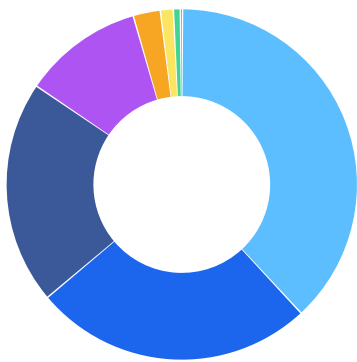

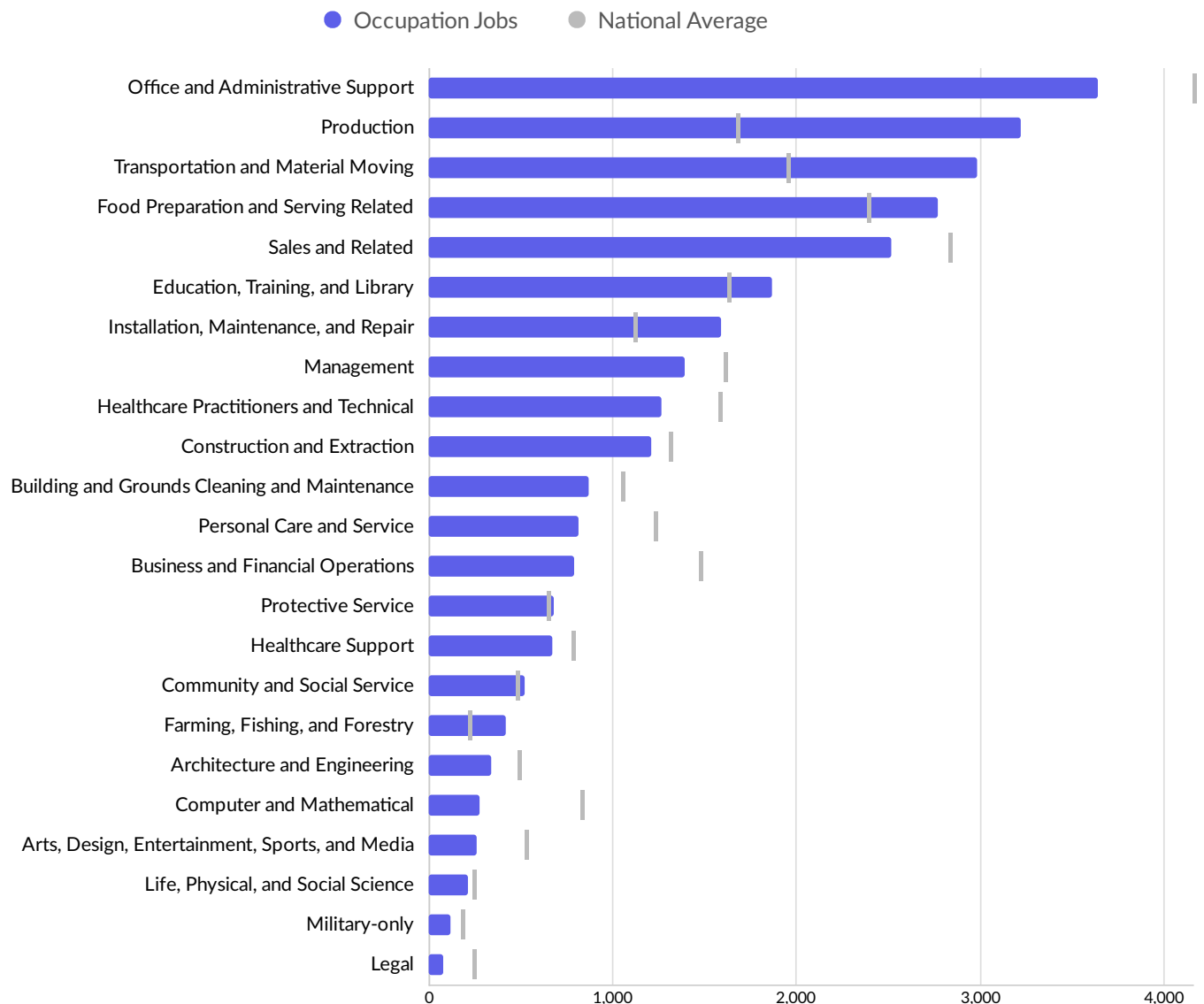

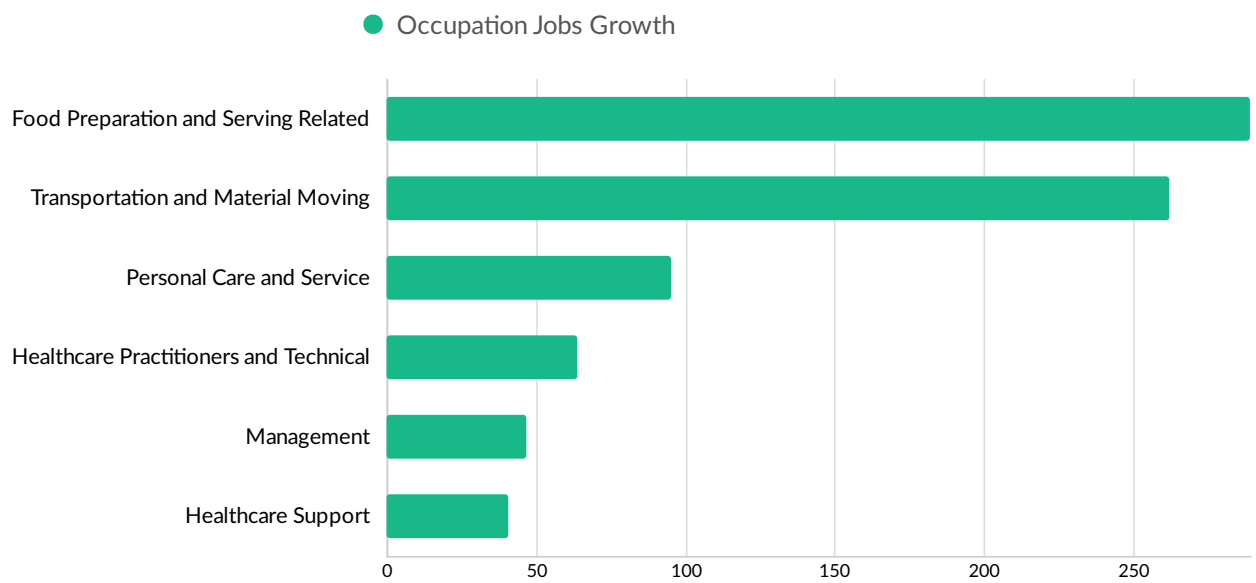

Largest Occupations



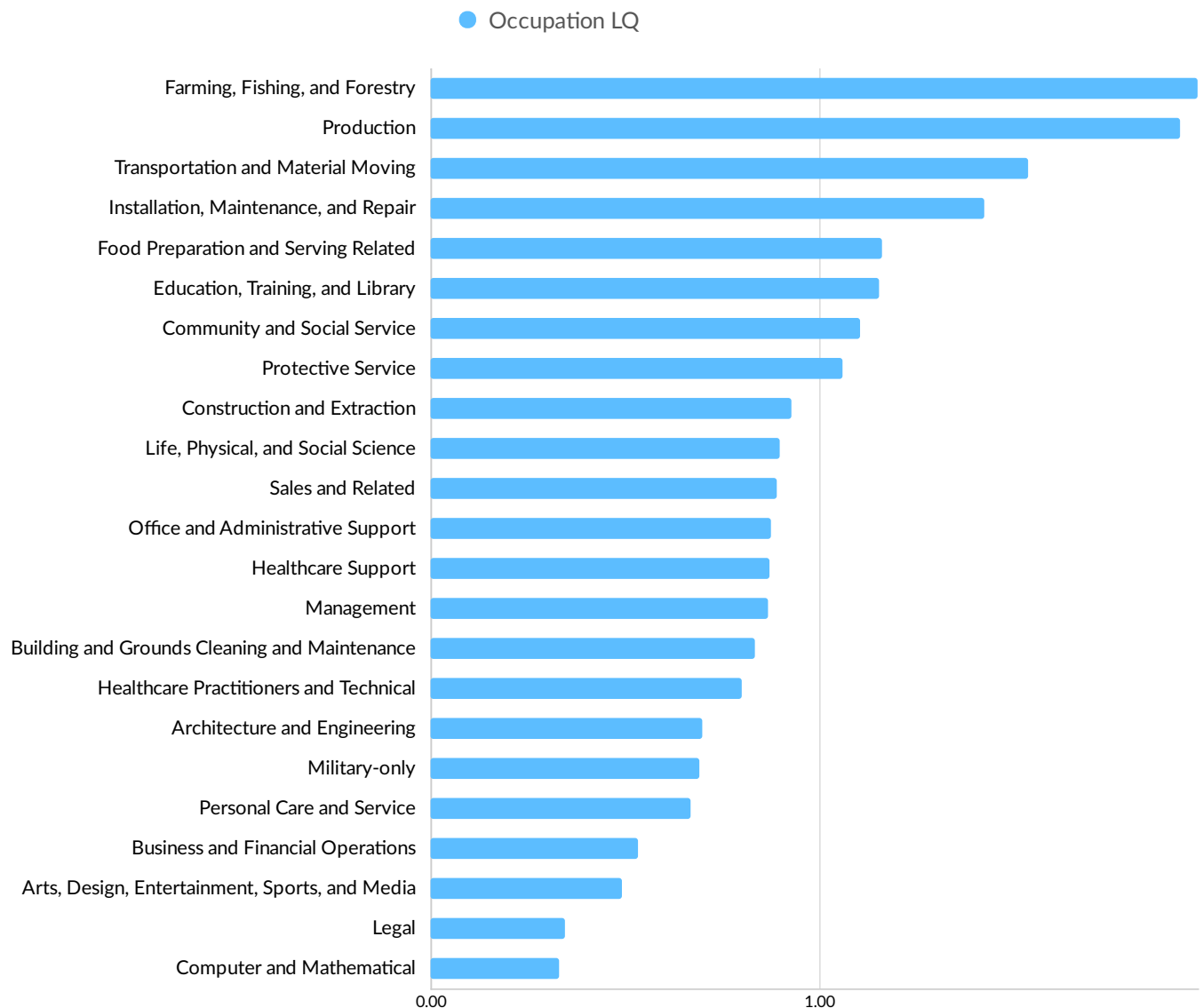

Top Growing Occupations



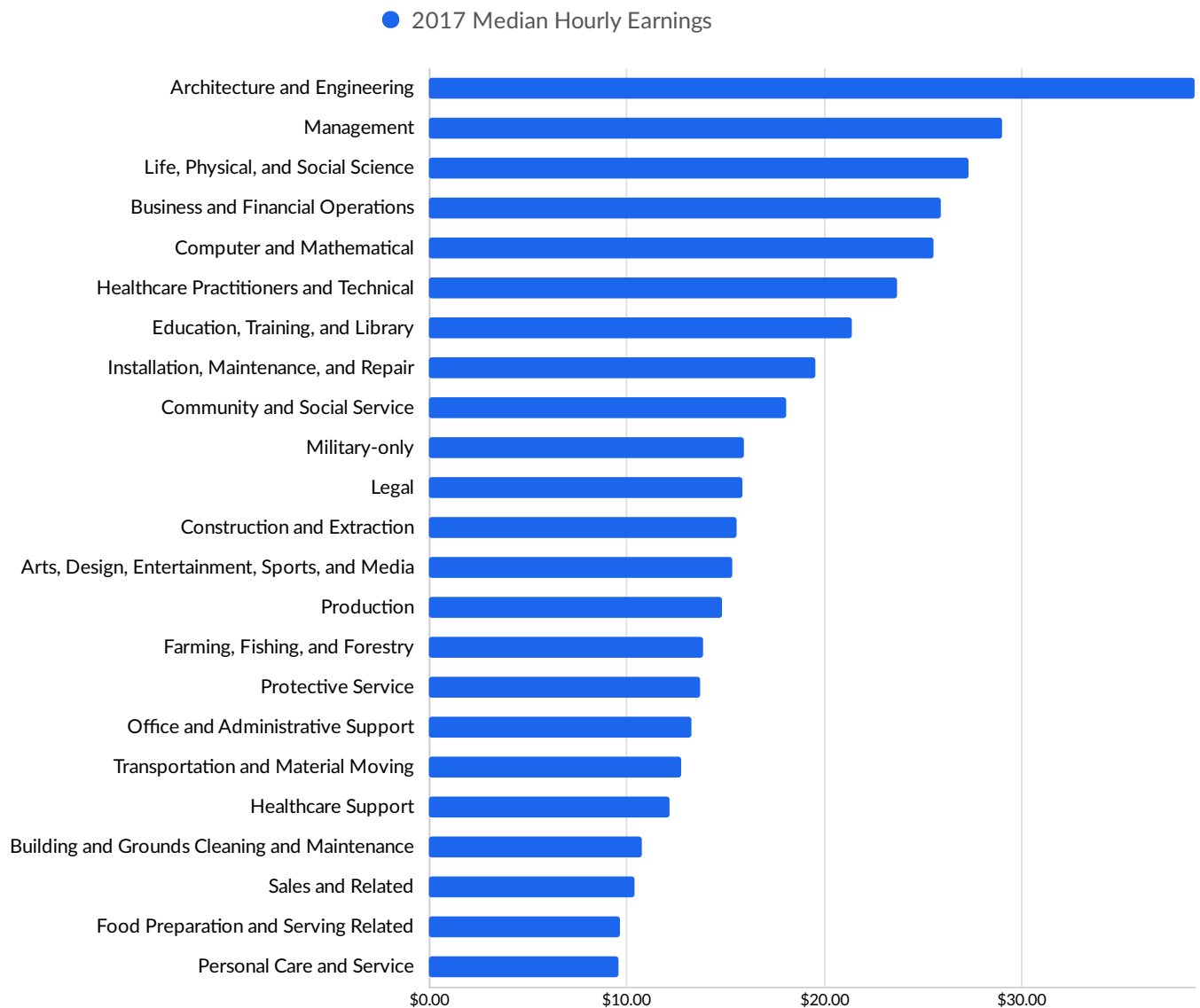

Top Occupation LQ



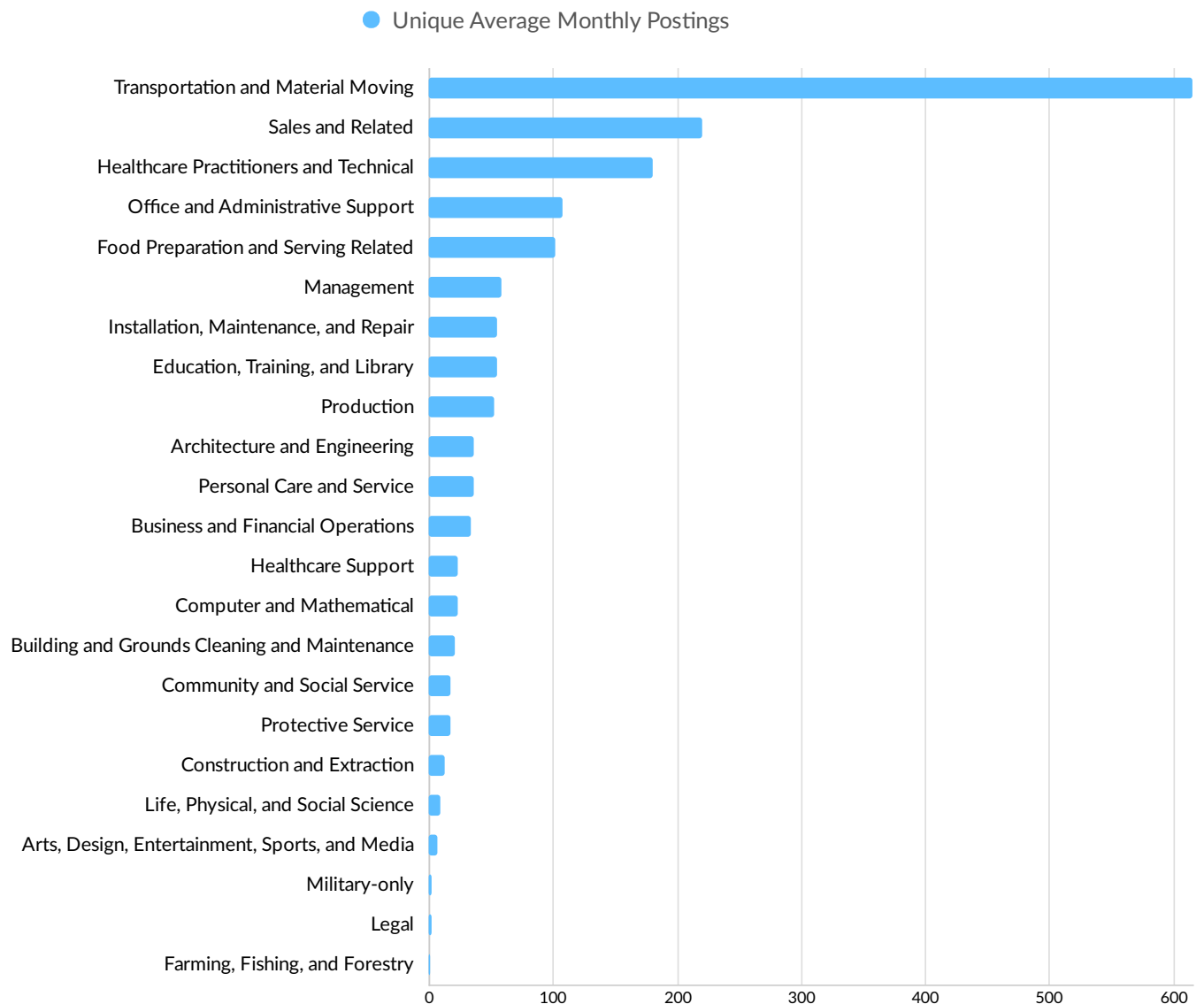

Top Occupation Earnings



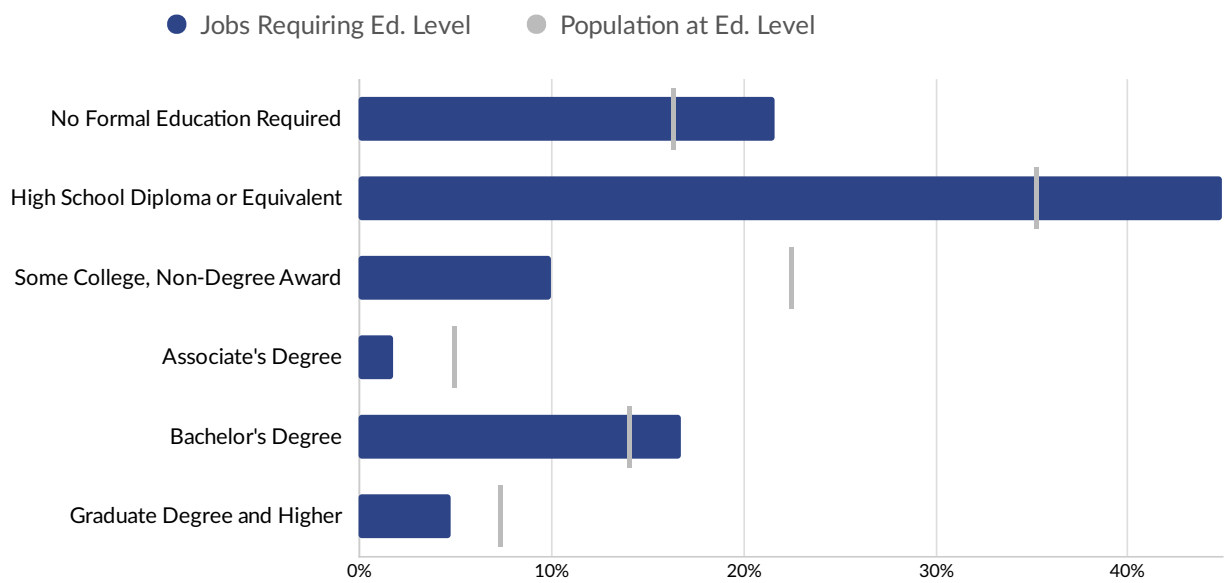
