



Labor Force Participation Rate Trends






Unemployment Rate Trends

Randolph County, AR had a January 2019 unemployment rate of 4.83%, decreasing from 7.90% 5 years before.






Millennials

Retirement risk is high in Randolph County, AR. The national average for an area this size is 5,005 people 55 or older, while there are 5,882 here.




Violent Crime

Property Crime


Randolph County, AR has 28.3 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 24.21 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ














