- As of 2018 the region's population increased by 1.0% since 2013, growing by 1,267. Population is expected to increase by 1.1% between 2018 and 2023, adding 1,435.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs increased by 1.8% in Sebastian County, AR from 70,028 to 71,280. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 6.4%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 56.7% to 54.3% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.0% of Sebastian County, AR residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.6% below the national average), and **7.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Employment Services, and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.






Unemployment Rate Trends


Millennials

Sebastian County, AR has 8,549 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 7,449.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Sebastian County, AR. The national average for an area this size is 36,521 people 55 or older, while there are 36,204 here.




Violent Crime

Property Crime


Sebastian County, AR has 44.6 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 24.21 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP




