Takeaways

- As of 2018 the region's population **declined by 3.3**% since 2013, falling by 559. Population is expected to **decrease by 2.3**% between 2018 and 2023, losing 374.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs declined by 6.8% in Van Buren County, AR from 4,560 to 4,249. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 15.0%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 45.5% to 42.8% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **9.0% of Van Buren County, AR residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.6% below the national average), and **5.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Nursing Care Facilities (Skilled Nursing Facilities), Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and General Merchandise Stores, including Warehouse Clubs and Supercenters.





Van Buren County, AR had a January 2019 unemployment rate of 6.63%, decreasing from 8.08% 5 years before.





Van Buren County, AR has 1,518 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 960.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Van Buren County, AR. The national average for an area this size is 4,706 people 55 or older, while there are 6,932 here.




Violent Crime

Property Crime


Van Buren County, AR has 20.22 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 24.21 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ










