## **Economy Overview**

Population decreased by 583 over the last 5 years and is projected to decrease by 400 over the next 5 years. 2,113

Jobs decreased by 171 over the last 5 years but are projected to grow by 11 over the next 5 years.

- As of 2018 the region's population **declined by 8.3**% since 2013, falling by 583. Population is expected to **decrease by 6.2**% between 2018 and 2023, losing 400.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs declined by 7.5% in Woodruff County, AR from 2,284 to 2,113. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 15.7%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 58.0% to 53.0% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.3% of Woodruff County, AR residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.3% below the national average), and **5.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Crop Production, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).






### **Unemployment Rate Trends**


Millennials

Woodruff County, AR has 1,032 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 1,361.




**Veterans** 

Woodruff County, AR has 576 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 382.




**Retiring Soon** 

Retirement risk is high in Woodruff County, AR. The national average for an area this size is 1,873 people 55 or older, while there are 2,480 here.




**Violent Crime**

**Property Crime** 


Woodruff County, AR has 14.59 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 24.21 per 1,000 people.






### Top Industry LQ









#### **Largest Occupations**






#### **Top Occupation LQ**






#### **Top Occupation Earnings**




