
#### **Takeaways**

- From 2013 to 2018, jobs increased by 6.3% in 7 Arkansas Counties from 108,317 to 115,172. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 1.9%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 56.4% to 56.8% between 2013 and 2018.

- The top three industries in 2018 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.




















#### **Top Growing Industries**






#### Top Industry LQ






#### **Top Industry GRP**





## **Educational Pipeline**

In 2017, there were 5,323 graduates in 7 Arkansas Counties. This pipeline has grown by 2% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from Liberal Arts and Sciences/Liberal Studies, Curriculum and Instruction, and Elementary and Middle School Administration/Principalship.
